Reën bring skade; nog dalk oppad

Montagu het weer die swaarste gely onder die onlangse swaar neerslae toe die R62 tussen Montagu en Ashton vir byna twee dae gesluit was vir verkeer en die riool pompstasie oorstroom het.

Hierdie oorstromings het groot ongerief veroorsaak aangesien diegene wie in Montagu woon maar in Ashton werk en andersom, nie by hul werksplekke kon uitkom nie of geforseer is om langer roetes te neem.

Skoolkinders is ook nadelig geraak hierdeur, maar gelukkig is nooddienste nie sodanig geaffekteer nie.

Geen ernstige skade aan privaat eiendom is aangemeld nie, maar die munisipaliteit het die skade aan die munisipale infrastruktuur op tussen R500 000 en R700 000.

Volgens Jan Durand, Bestuurder: Rampbestuur, is die skade meestal aangerig aan die pad-oppervlakte en paaie wat oor lae brûe loop.

Rivier-oewers en water- en rioolpype is ook beskadig.

"Die skade is nie beperk tot 'n spesifieke area nie alhoewel die meeste skade in Robertson en Montagu aangerig is, maar skade is aan die pad-oppervlakte en lae brûe regoor ons munisipale area aangerig en verdien aandag," het Durand verduidelik.

Verskeie paaie is ook tydelik gesluit en motoriste moes noodgedwonge alternatiewe roetes kies.

"Die R60 tussen Swellendam en Ashton is vir ongeveer 24-uur gesluit en verkeer is herlei deur Bonnievale na die N2. Die R62

tussen Montagu en Ashton is oorspronklik gesluit as gevolg van die oorstrooming van die pad-oppervlak by Keurkloof, maar later ook by die Voortrekker-brug by Montagu se ingang. Hierdie pad was vir ongeveer 36-uur gesluit en die R318 deur Keisie/Koo was die alternatief."

Die R62 tussen Montagu en Barrydale was ook vir ongeveer 24-uur gesluit as gevolg van die oorstrooming van die pad-oppervlakte by Meulplaas en die lae waterbrug na Montagu-Wes was gesluit vir nagenoeg 24-uur.

Die Brerivier het ook sy walle oorstroom en die lae waterbrug in Bonnievale is steeds vir verkeer gesluit.

"Ons doen 'n ernstige beroep op inwoners en padverbruikers om tydens hierdie tye

alle tydelike padtekens en waarskuwings, asook instruksies van pad-beamptes of polisie- of verkeersbeamptes, te gehoorsaam," aldus Durand.

Durand doen ook 'n beroep op voetgangers om nie te probeer om brûe tydens swaar reën te probeer oorskry nie en indien daar enige twyfel is oor die veiligheid van die brug, eerder daarheen te besluit en die owerhede van die toestand van die brug in te lig.

"Indien enigeen van enigiets weet wat ander inwoners kan help en so kan bydrae tot 'n veiliger samelewing, moet hulle ook asseblief die owerhede in kennis stel.

Die Suid-Afrikaanse Weerburo waarsku dat swaar neerslae ook in die volgende maand verwag kan word en Durand het

inwoners gemaak om deur die media op hoogte te bly van enige ernstige weer-waarskuwings.

Wanneer hierdie oorstromings met ander jare vergelyk word, is dit nie so erg soos dit in November 2008 was toe die hele munisipale area 'n ramppgebied verklaar is en die munisipaliteit skade ter waarde van R500 000 herstel het en die skade in die munisipale area deur die provinsie op nagenoeg R60-miljoen geraam is.

In 2003 is daar ook versoek dat die area tot ramppgebied verklaar word nadat Montagu weer van die buite-wêreld afgesny is en die skade aan die infrastruktuur in die area op byna R150-miljoen geskat is.

1 Wanneer laas het jy die area besoek?

Die laaste keer toe ek in die Langeberg Munisipaliteit was, was gedurende die naweek van 19 – 20 Februarie. Gedurende daardie naweek het ek in 'n gastehuis in Bonnievale gebly, maar kon darem tyd maak om in Robertson 'n draai te gaan maak.

2 Why did you visit the area at that time?

I attended the wedding celebrations of dear friends who grew up in Bonnievale and although they worked and stayed in Pretoria at the time, they decided to celebrate their union in Bonnievale.

3 Did you manage to appreciate anything in particular in the town(s)?

I enjoyed the peacefulness and tranquility of Bonnievale and the effort put into tourism development in the area. Die gastehuis waarin ons vir die twee aande gebly het, het gedatueer uit die 18de eeu en dit was iets besonder.

We also took some time to appreciate the wines of the area when we took a trip to Robertson for some wine tasting. I must say, you have some of our country's best wines in this valley.

4 Wat was jou indrukke oor die natuurlike skoonheid van die area?

Lush and captivating! Truly a wonderful area for a relaxed and quiet weekend retreat. Die mense van hierdie area is so bevoorreg om omring te word deur die Langeberge en om die Bredrivers te hê wat rustig deur die vallei hardloop.

5 Het jy enige van die munisipale geriewe gebruik en ervaar?

Ons was daar gedurende die naweek en kon dus nie die biblioteke, munisipale museums, toerisme dienste of munisipale dienste gebruik nie. 6 What were your impressions of these facilities?

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'I AM WHERE I ALWAYS WANTED TO BE; HOME'

Langeberg Municipality's municipal manager, Andreas Mokweni, left the area as a child in pursuit of education. He returned and left again. This time in pursuit of better opportunities. Four years ago he returned again. This time to live his dream and to supervise the creation of the kind of communities he could not know as a child.

Q Tell us a little more about your upbringing and childhood.

A I was born in Robertson, in an area then known as Muiskraalkop. As a child I grew up with my grandfather who was a shepherd.

Q What experiences from your childhood will you always remember?

A The one thing that I will always remember from my childhood and that will always stand out in my life experience, is the lack of educational facilities especially for the African population during my upbringing.

Up to 1970 there was no school for African children in Robertson.

Q How did you then overcome this educational hurdle that threatened to derail your future?

Being conscience of the importance of education, my parents who were very poor, decided that something had to be done about this problem. As a result, they decided in 1966 to send me to my grandparents who were at that point deposed to the Eastern Cape due to the apartheid laws.

So I started my schooling at Thembekile Primary School in Ilings Township just outside Queenstown.

Life was not easy. My father was the only breadwinner with a large family of 7 children and he earned a weekly wage of about R 7,50. From that he had to pay rent, water, feed us and buy clothes.

From this he still had to make sure that we were also surviving in the Eastern Cape.

Q Anyone who you cherished from that period, who you feel embedded to even now as you are a sought-after expert on matters of local government?

A I wish to express my sincere appreciation and gratitude to the late Mr Howard Mbi, who was a petrol attendant at Roelou Barry at that time.

When he saw this disaster of lack of schools, he started a school at his small three-roomed house.

Those of us who had some formal schooling also attended but were also offered a chance to assist Mrs Mbi who was mostly on her own trying to teach us. So when the school was opened for the first time in September 1970 a process had to be put in place to slot us into various classes that we would be responsible for.

We can easily say the principle of recognition of prior learning started in Nkqubela.

For those who are my age in Nkqubela, I wish to say if you can read today, don't thank a teacher but the late Mr and Mrs Mbi who work tirelessly to avert what would have been a major disaster created by the apartheid system.

Q Why did you leave Robertson for the second time?

A I left Robertson in 1984 in search for better education in the City.

You must understand that at that time I had a very good job at Nestle and with (a bright future I must say).

At the age of 24, I was already in the junior management ranks of Nestle as the supervisor responsible for processing, a level below that of the production manager.

However, I had to make a choice between pursuing a career with limited education or get more education and equip me for the future.

Q What was your first "city" experience like (after you have left Robertson)?

A Cape Town was not easy.

I battled to find employment, and when I found a job I still had to apply for a Section 10-transfer to Cape Town in terms of the Influx Control Act.

I then had to register at a hostel in Nyanga before I could be registered by the Labour Officer. So I ended up with hostel I never stayed in or been to it.

Naturally, the city life is much faster than what I was used to but I adapted very well.

Q How did you end up in public service?

A I started in the public service as I was a teacher for 2 years, joined the Bantu Affairs Administration Board, Department of Justice as a Court Interpreter before joining the Permanent Building Society.

In 1992 I joined the City of Cape Town as a Property Practitioner and was soon thereafter appointed as the Deputy Branch Head of the Property Department.

I enjoyed Local Government so much because you deal directly with the communities and can see the difference you making in the lives of the people.

Q You have dedicated your life to being of service to others even when you could have had a successful career in corporate business. Why did you decide against corporate business but instead came back home?

A I get my satisfaction in helping others than a personal benefit.

When I accepted the job in Langeberg Municipality, then Breede River Winelands, I took a R100 000 drop in my salary but I believe that money is a short term motivator but job satisfaction, knowing that you touching people's lives in a meaningful way, gives me lasting satisfaction.

So I came back to the are of my birth to plough back and assist with the programme of poverty eradication. That is why people remain the centre of development in whatever I am doing.

Q How would you compare the area that you left so many years ago with the area you returned to a few years back?

A Obviously when I left, Robertson was still on its own. Today we talking about an amalgamated municipality.

We need to capitalize on the strengths of the region and transform it to an economic hub. We have the competitive edge on tourism, the wines, low crime rate, scenery and the people. These must be used to reverse socio-economic situation.

Q What were some of the first things that you wanted to change and did change?

Housing was and still is priority number one yet the organisation was not geared to provide houses.

I have now put the organisation in a state of readiness but we still need some serious capacity in terms of expertise.

Promoting sound corporate governance and create a responsive administration.

Q How did your experience in the City of Cape Town assist in manage this change?

A The City of Cape Town is a huge organisation. It employs 25 000 people and highly skilled staff.

This has exposed me to various service delivery concepts that can be adapted to the needs of a smaller municipality.

I must say though the challenges here are greater than those of the City of Cape Town.

Money is not readily available here with huge socio-economic challenges.

Q What makes you come to work everyday? What about your work inspires and motivates you?

A My work is never boring as each day is unique. No two days are the same just as problems of the people are different from one to the other.

Knowing that what I do is changing people's lives is the driving force behind me.

Q Looking forward, what do you think should still be done to create the kind of area that you would like to leave as a legacy?

Poverty must be eradicated to create a prosperous community, houses must be built to ensure that every citizen of the Langeberg-region has access to a house and roads must be tarred and maintained. We need to ensure a clean environment with adequate job opportunities.

Q ...and administration? (What do you think should still be done to create the kind of administration that you would like to leave as a legacy?)

A The administration is functioning well but we need to ensure that we have a skilled administration with the appropriate technical competence to deliver services to all citizens.

I am quite happy that we are investing wisely in this regard and should be there within the next 3 to 5 years.

Q Are you happy/content/satisfied in your work?

A I am extremely happy and content with my work.

There are many challenges in my work but job satisfaction keeps me going. I am surrounded by good and loyal colleagues as well supporting politicians. The Executive and the Mayoral Committee makes it easier for me to come to work.

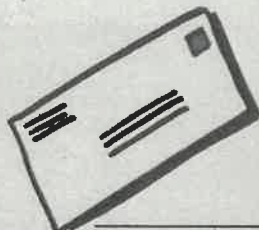
Talk to social workers, police officers, nurses and school principals about the needs within their respective fields and discuss different ways of helping them if you are still unsure of what to do on that day.

We do however call on the owners of all dogs to ensure that the dogs are always kept on a leash and that dogs are only allowed outside the yard under controlled circumstances.

Langeberg bekommerd oor gemors - hulp gesoek

'Berge van rommel, damme van ongebruikte water kan nie meer geduld word'- MB

Die Munisipale Bestuurder (MB) van die Langeberg Munisipaliteit, Andreas Mokweni, het 'n dringende beroep op alle inwoners gedoen om die munisipaliteit te help verseker dat die vallei rommel- en gemorsvry word en bly.

My het sy kommer uit gespreek oor die "groeende onverantwoordelikheid" in ons gemeenskappe en het ook verwys na die vermorsting van waardevolle bronne soos elektrisiteit en water.

"Dit bekommerd my dat daar steeds mense in ons gemeenskappe is wie sommer 'n blikkie Coke sal leegmaak en sonder huiwer daardie blikkie net daar langs die straat sal gooi," het Mokweni gesê.

Hy wys ook daarop dat gemeenskappe nie die werklike omvang van vermorsting beseef nie en dat hierdie onverantwoordelikheid nadelige gevolge vir die toekoms kan inhou.

"As ons dan nie bekommerd is oor onself nie, dan moet ons dink aan ons kinders en hulle kinders dink en die tipe omgewing wat ons vir hulle gaan agterlaat," het Mokweni gemaak.

"Ons kan nie meer net vuilnis rondgooi soos ons wil nie, of water vermors soos ons goeddink nie. So kan ons ook nie net elektrisiteit

onverantwoordelik gebruik nie," meen hy.

"Daar is so baie wat gemeenskappe kan doen om hul omgewing te help. Dit is so eenvoudig soos, help om rommel te herwin, gebruik 'n glas water om tande te borsel in plaas van 'n lopende kraan of om 'n bietjie water te kook vir een koppie tee of koffie," verduidelik die MB.

Hy het 'n beroep op gemeenskappe en huishoudings gedoen om hul verantwoordelikheid teenoor die omgewing na te kom deur herwinning, herverbruik vermindering deel van hul daaglikse lewe te maak.

"Diegene wie nog dink dat daar vir ewig water of bronne sal wees waarmee elektrisiteit gekweek word, leef in 'n droomwêreld. Enige kundige sal jou vertel dat ons waterbronne is amper uitgeput en ons het nie meer so baie steenkool om elektrisiteit te verskaf nie," verduidelik die MB.

"Die waarheid is dat bevolkings groei, maar nie natuurlike hulpbronne nie," waarsku Mokweni.

Hy noem dan dat die munisipaliteit onlangs begin het om 'n twee-sak herwinningsprojek te begin wat die munisipale gebied van stapel te stuur (meer hieroor binne) en doen 'n beroep op alle



huishoudings om die munisipaliteit in hierdie poging te ondersteun.

"Ook wil ons hê dat ons huishoudings water meer spaarsaam moet gebruik asook nie elektrisiteit onnodig te mors nie, want ons kan dit nie bekostig nie," sê hy.

Hy meld ook dat die munisipaliteit daarin streef om mense die middelpunt van ontwikkeling te maak, maar dat mense dan groter verantwoordelikheid moet aanvaar vir die omgewing wat dan die middelpunt van hul bestaan is.

Two-bag recycling system rolled-out: Seperate at source to reduce waste



The Langeberg Municipality is going green by introducing a new recycling initiatives. It is the aim of Council to reduce the amount of waste going to the landfill site by increasing the percentage of recycling from 19% to 30% by 2012.

This project will be piloted in Montagu to fine tune implementation and then roll-out to the entire area.

The Langeberg Municipal area has a centralised landfill site, which is located in Ashton. This means that all the waste of the entire area is disposed at the Ashton landfill site.

Previously, landfill sites used to exist at each of the towns. The site in Robertson was closed (2002/03) and is currently rehabilitating and the sites at Montagu, Bonnievale and McGregor are being used for green waste and builders rubble only.

The landfill site is Ashton comprises an area of 2.1 Ha and was constructed in 1998. Due to the landfill nearing its capacity, the site was extended in 2005.

Once again, this site is nearing its capacity and council is investigating options to reduce the waste that goes to the landfill site to prolong the life of this site. The application of establishing a new landfill site has already started in 1999 and studies to identify a new site has been completed and is currently in the appeal process. However, the process involved in establishing an operational landfill site may take several years.

REDUCING WASTE TO THE LANDFILL

The Municipality will introduce an additional bag together with the well-known black refuse bag. This bag will be a clear bag with the sole purpose of collecting all recyclable materials such as paper, plastic, glass and metal. This system will be known as the two-bag system and the additional bag will be collected together with the black bag on your specific refuse collection day.

Thus with the new 2 bag system, the waste collection service will also take all recyclable materials from our homes and save residents the trouble of taking different containers to different recycling depots around town.

Residents are requested to place ALL recyclable materials (glass, tins, paper, card, and mixed or pure plastics) into one bag (clear), and the remaining disposable items in a black bag - on their usual garbage collection day.

The clear bag will go to the recycling centre at the Ashton landfill site where the waste will be sorted further into various categories. Once sorted in will be transported to larger recycling facilities outside our area.

In this manner waste to the landfill site will be reduced and the lifetime of this landfill site extended.

Below is a table that shows the daily amount of waste produced in our area and the amount that goes to the landfill site. By increasing the amount of recycled waste, we will decrease the amount of waste going to the landfill site.

WHY SORT YOUR WASTE

Sorting at source assists the municipality to increase recycling. Once recyclable materials are mixed with household refuse like old food and other non-recyclable materials, they become non-recyclable.

The Municipality therefore call on the community to give their cooperation and assist the municipality with this project that will benefit the entire area.

SOURCE SEPARATION

Source separation means that all mandated recyclable materials must be kept separate from garbage at the point where they are generated (e.g. your home, office or classroom) until they reach a recycling plant. At no

point should recyclables be mixed with garbage.

WHY RECYCLE

It saves natural resources - Making products from recycled materials instead of virgin materials conserves natural resources while reducing raw material extraction.

It saves energy - It usually takes less energy to make recycled products. Making new aluminium from recycled aluminium takes 95% less energy than making new aluminium from bauxite ore.

It protects our clean air and water - In most cases, making products from recycled materials creates less air and water pollution than making products from virgin materials.

It saves disposal capacity - When the materials are recycled into new products, they don't go into landfills or incinerators.

It can save money and creates jobs - The recycling process creates far more jobs than landfills or incinerators. In addition, recycling reduces disposal costs.

WHAT TO PLACE IN THE CLEAR BAG

Please separate the following recyclables from your garbage and place them in the clear bag provided. Note that the recyclables must be clean and dry; as wet paper will become useless.

Aluminum cans

Steel (tin) cans

Glass bottles & jars

Plastic bottles, bags

Newspapers

Corrugated cardboard

Mixed paper (junk mail, magazines)

Not only will you be assisting the Municipality to implement this initiative but also you will contribute to saving the environment and preventing global warming.

Emergency ready

The Langeberg Municipality is continuously monitoring the weather forecasts for the Municipal area. In case of any severe weather warning the information is disseminated to all relevant role players.

The municipality has an extensive disaster management plan in place to deal with emergency or disaster scenarios within the area.

A number of monitoring, early warning systems and response procedures are in place regarding the state of readiness for the predicted heavy weather conditions.

This includes the continuous monitoring of low water bodies and roads within the area to ensure that the surfaces are safe.

Traffic and other developments will be on standby to close off any roads and/or bridges deemed unsafe. Road users are requested to adhere to these warnings and signs for their own safety.

their own safety.

All role players are on alert and will receive regular updates on the situation and should multi-disciplinary action be required, a Disaster Management Operational Centre (DMOC) will be activated in Robertson.

This Centre will comprise of representatives of the Municipality's Disaster Management Team, Cape Winelands District Municipality's Disaster Management Team, South African Police Services, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and other applicable discipline in accordance with the requirements of the Disaster Management Plan.

All support will also be available pending the severity of the situation.

The DMOC, through the members of the Operational Management Team, monitors mitigation operations according to priorities for early

warning of potentially affected areas, the saving of lives, emergency rescue, other disaster management mitigation strategies, keeping record of all incidents, events and actions and informs all strategic role players and control centres at least once per hour regarding developments.

The municipality also has contingency plans in place to ensure the delivery of basic services (water, sewerage and power) in affected areas with the shortest disruption possible, in case of failure.

Storm water drains are well maintained and regular checks are in process to ensure that all water ways are clear.

Should any emergency arise people should contact the Langeberg Municipal Call Centre at 0800 30 11 11 who is on alert and will disseminate information to the relevant role players.

Gratis elektrisiteit aan deernisgevalle op landelike gebiede

Huishoudings op landelike gemeenskappe sal vanaf hierdie maand ook kan aansoek doen vir deernis-ondersteuning, maar sal slegs die gratis elektrisiteit kan kry.

Hierdie besluit is tydens die laaste vergadering van die vorige raad bekragtig nadat die begroting deur die voormalige burgemeester, John Ngonyama, aan die raad voorgelê is.

Ngonyama het in 2010 gevra dat die die moontlikheid, om gratis elektrisiteit en water aan landelike gemeenskappe uit te brei, ondersoek moet word, maar daar is toe bevind dat dit op hierdie stadium slegs moontlik is om gratis elektrisiteit te verskaf.

"Die waarheid is dat ons ekonomiese grotendeels op landbou steun en dat talle van ons inwoners hulle op plase bevind," verduidelik die munisipale bestuurder, Mnr Andreas Mokweni.

"Ons moes toe na maniere kyk om ook hierdie gemeenskappe wie ook gebuk gaan onder die selfde sosio-ekonomiese omstandighede as diegene in van ons woonbuurte, aan die hand te vat," aldus Mokweni.

Huishoudings met 'n inkomste van minder as R3 000 per maand kan kwalifiseer.

"Al wat hierdie huishoudings moet doen, is om 'n aansoekvorm by enige munisipale kantoor af te haal, dit te voltooi en dan weer na die munisipale kantoor terug te stuur," sê Mokweni.

Elke huishouding wat dan aansoek doen, moet oor 'n voorafbetaal elektrisiteitsmeter (prepaid meter) beskik wat aan die vereistes van die munisipaliteit voldoen. Indien die huishouding wel oor 'n voorafbetaal meter beskik, maar wat nie aan die munisipale vereistes voldoen, moet die meter op die eienaar se kostes vervang word.

Plaaseienaars sal ook steeds

aanspreklik gehou word vir die laagspanningsnetwerk vanaf die hoof meterpunt of transformator en indien daar nie 'n hoof meterpunt is nie, moet daar een onder die transformator aangebring word.

"Ons moet verstaan dat hierdie huise op plase nie aan die bewoners behoort en daarom kan ons nie net gaan maak en doen soos ons wil in enige huis op landelike gebiede nie. Ons is egter oortuig dat ons die ondersteuning van plaaseienaars sal kry," sê Mokweni.

Wanneer die aansoek vir deernis goedgekeur is, kan die aansoeker elektrisiteit by enige verkooppunt koop en hierdie eenhede sal dan teen die rekening van die plaaseienaar gekrediteer word om te verhoed dat die plaaseienaar dubbel aangeslaan word.

Die goedgekeurde aansoeker sal dan elke maand gratis 50 eenhede elektrisiteit ontvang.

FLOODS: Rain not the only problem; solutions sought

When the Voortrekker bridge at the entrance of Montagu and the low bridges at Drew and Die Plaat (both in Bonnievale) get flooded, the rain is not the only culprit.

According to Jan Durand, Manager: Disaster Management, other natural factors are also to blame for this.

"Flooding occurs due to a number of different reasons. One reason is of course the excessive rainfalls over a short time span, when the dimensions of water thoroughfare, such as water canals, rivulet, rivers and dams, can simply not contain the amount of water that has fallen," Durand explains.

"The formation of debris, dislodged vegetation and any other obstruction hampering the flow of the water, which will simply be moved with the water until it reaches an unmovable barrier like bridges, where the debris will converge, impeding water flow which will then flow over and around obstructions."

"Other reasons are mountain fires. After a fire we get top soil deterioration that results in the formation of vegetation debris that are loosened and washed into rivers, adding to the formation of debris," Durand says.

He also blames the "formation of sand and silt" that occurs due to water flow that is moved along the river.

"When the water flow slows down, due to obstruction, or

confluence with other rivers, this sand and silt will settle on the bottom of the river, having the effect that the river depth is decreased," he explains.

The situation, Durand says, was brought under the attention of the authorities as part of the claims for financial aid due to the last two flooding incidents that occurred.

The main contribution was, however for the restoration of damages to infrastructure. Although claims were made for the rehabilitation of the rivers, it must be noted that during that period, flooding also occurred in various other parts of the Western Cape and there was simply not enough funds to address all the rivers.

"Another claim has been forwarded to the district and provincial authorities which will be addressed during the following weeks," he announced.

The municipal manager, Mr Andreas Mokweni, also mentioned that according to the constitution, rivers do not fall within the ambit of local governments but are the responsibility of higher spheres.

"Another related problem is the fact that the roads crossing these rivers also fall under the jurisdiction of higher spheres but while there is very little we can do, we continuously engage with regional, provincial and national government to help us alleviate the dire consequences of the flooding on our community," Mokweni said.

"Zadlula ezontsuku, andisanyanzelekanga ukuba ndiyenze lonto. Ngoku ndifumana umholo ondenza ndikwazi ukucwangcisa ikamva lam," utshilo uKobe omnyaka ingamashumi amahlanu nanye ongutata wabanwana abane.

uMitchelle ongomama wabantwana abathandathu, naye orhola imali engamakhulu asibhozo ngeveko kwiziko le-recycling ePhini eZolani uyavumelana noKobe.

"Kuvakala kumnandi ukuyazi into yokuba unomholo owufumanayo ngempela. Lo masipala ngekhe ayazi ukuba elithuba libaluleke kangakanani kum, kokokuqala kwiminyaka elishumi elinesihlanu ukuba ndibenomholo osisigxina," wongeze esithsho uMitchelle. Kukho nabanye abantu abalishumi abazebenza kweliziko le-recycling. Abaninzi babo babesenze lento yayisenziwa nguKobe noMitchelle phambi kokuba bafumane lomsebenzi.

Vir 15 jaar het Solomon Kobe (tweede foto) en Elizabeth Mitchellle (eerste foto) by die afvalterrein in Zolani gekrap vir koper, aluminium en ander metale om aan iemand anders te verkoop. Vandag werk hulle onderskeidelik as afvalterreerder en operateur by die Recyclingssentrum in Zolani en verdien R400 per week. "Die munisipaliteit sal nie weet hoe baie dit ver my beteken," aldus Mitchellle.

Raad spandeer miljoene aan water-infrastruktuur

R28.4-miljoen. Dit is die bedrag wat die Langeberg Munisipaliteit tans bestee om die watermetwerk en -infrastruktuur op te gradeer.

Volgens Andreas Mokweni, die munisipale bestuurder, kon die munisipale watermetwerk nie byhou met die groei van die munisipaliteit nie.

"Ons water-infrastruktuur is verouderd en kon nie byhou met die snelle uitbreidings nie en was ons as 'n verantwoordbare munisipaliteit genoodsaak om iets daaromtrent te doen," verduidelik die munisipale bestuurder.

"Ons moet in ons gemeenskappe belê en omdat ons 'n munisipaliteit is wat ernstig daarop is om van die beste dienste en geriewe aan ons gemeenskappe te bied, het ons besluit om ons Munisipale Infrastruktuurbekeennings vir hierdie doel te gebruik," voer Mokweni aan.

"Tweedens," voeg hy by, "kon ons nie bekostig om water, wat 'n skaarser bron word, te versors nie en moes ons na maniere kyk om ons water optimaal te benut sodat ons nie water tekort kon hê omdat water, as gevolg van die verouderde watermetwerk, verlore gaan."

Meer as die helfte van die totale bedrag, R13.6-miljoen, word gespandeer om die massa water toevoer, die water behandelingswerke en die waterrehabilitasie netwerk op te gradeer asook om die Ashbury Reservoir te bou.

In Ashton is R5.6-miljoen aangewend om die waterrehabilitasie netwerk te verbeter, in Bonnievale word R4.4-miljoen aangewend om die waterbehandelingswerke op te moderniseer en in McGregor is byna R5-miljoen gebruik om 'n 2-megaliter reservoir te bou.

Volgens Maynard Johnson, Bestuurder: Streeks Ingenieursdienste, is daar verskeie redes wat hierdie aanleiding gegee het.

"In Montagu het die suivering van water stalling (die proses waar chemikalieë by die water gevoeg word om flokkulasie te

verseker) en opvloei-suivering ingesluit. Sô is die vloek wat gevorm is, deur filters verwyder, maar as gevolg van die kort proses, kon die waterwerke nie byhou om al die vloek te verwyder nie," verduidelik Johnson.

"Die regte suiveringsprosedure sluit in stalling, flokkulasie, sedimentering, filtrering en ontsmetting. Een van die mees belangrikste prosesse, sedimentering, waar die water deur 'n groot tank vloei teen 'n spoed wat nie 0.4-0.7 meter per sekonde oorskry, wat dan die onsuiver deeltjies, wat vloek vorm as gevolg van stalling, toelaat om op die bodem van die tank te lê sodat die skoon water van bo af getrek kan word, was uit die proses gelaat. Dit is hoekom die mense van Montagu water gekry het waarin daar klein deeltjies geswem het," verduidelik Johnson verder.

In hierdie geval het ons ses settingskegels gebou om 6-megaliter water te hanteer.

Die rehabilitasie van watermetwerke, sê hy, is om die corbille en ou asbes-sement pype, wat gereeld bars en groot waterverliese meebring, te vervang.

"In Bonnievale, Montagu, Ashton en Robertson wissel die groottes van die pype tussen 75mm en 355mm en het die munisipaliteit reeds nagenoeg 7.4km pype vervang," noem Johnson.

"Ons is nou in ons tweede fase van hi-

erdie projek waar die ou pype vervang word asook die "midblok" stelsel in voorteen benadeelde gebiede. In hierdie fase beplan ons om 9km se pype te vervang," sê hy.

Ook in Bonnievale kon die waterbehandelingswerke nie die mas opkom nie.

"Die kapasiteit van die behandelingswerke wat beperk tot 2.1-megaliter per dag in die sedimenteringsafdeling. Die ontwerp is gedoen om die sedimenteringskapasiteit te verhoog met 'n addisionele 2-megaliter per dag. In Settingslenk en die nodige kanale is gebou en die 60-jaar oue filters is ook vervang."

Na 'n ondersoek in die water-situasie van McGregor is daar bevind dat die onbehandelde water bergingskapasiteit verhoog moes word asook die bergingskapasiteit van die gesuiwerde water en 'n 2-mega-liter reservoir is gebou.

Volgens Mokweni is die verbetering en opgradering van die watersuiveringsaanlegte, onbehandelde water toevoer so wel as die reservoir kapasiteit en pyplyne 'n proses wat nie ophou.

"Toekomstige projekte sluit in die opgradering van die Ashton waterbehandelingswerke, onbehandelde water bergingskapasiteit in McGregor, die opgradering van Robertson "siphon" en die verbetering van die kapasiteit van die Gungrope Dam in

Robertson," kondig die munisipale bestuurder aan.

The Langeberg Municipality is currently spending R28.4-million to upgrade and improve the water purification system and its water network.

According to Andreas Mokweni, the municipal manager, this investment was made due to the aging water infrastructure as well as the capacity that will not be able to cater for future needs.

More than half of the total budget, R13.6-million is spent in Montagu where the purification process has been improving through the construction of six settling basins with accommodating structure to also handle 6-megalitre per day.

Maynard Johnson, the civil engineering services manager, also explains that redundant and old asbestos cement pipes that burst a lot and causes huge water losses, were also replaced. A total length of 7.4km pipes were replaced in the first phase and an additional 9km will be replaced in the second phase.

The capacity of the Bonnievale treatment works was limited to 2.1-megaliter per day in the sedimentation section but its capacity has been doubled. This improvement cost R4.4 million.
