The year ahead



Major capital projects planned for Langeberg

Millions to be spent on infrastructure

The Langeberg Municipality will be spending millions of rands within the next financial year, to upgrade and improve infrastructure within the municipal area.

The infrastructure projects, identified in the 2014/2015 Budget Plan, will kick off in this month (July) earmarking the start of the municipality's new financial year. The Engineering Services Department will roll out several identified capital projects from July 2014 until June 2015. Such projects include the following:

Sewerage

For the purpose of increasing capacity, a substantial amount will be spent over the next financial year, to upgrade the sewerage systems within the Langeberg area.

A new Jet Vac machine will be purchased to the value of R2,9 million. This high pressure multi-purpose machine will benefit the whole of Langeberg, as its main purpose is to clean sewerage blockages and storm water lines. As from September 2014 it will also function as a backup truck for sewage removals.

The wastewater treatment works in Montagu will undergo an upgrade to the value of R1 907 500. This tender project will commence and continue during the period March 2015 to June 2015, and will ensure compliance to the standards of the Department of Water Affairs.

Roads and stormwater

The following amounts will be spent on the rebuilding and upgrading of roads:

- The stormwater system in Ward 2, Nkqubela will be upgraded in the period from July to December 2014. The project, valued at R490 000, comprises the construction of a stormwater channel to prevent the regular flooding of houses in the area.

- The construction of a retaining wall in Ward 4 (Viooltjie Crescent, Happy Valley) will commence in July until December 2014. The project, valued at R100 000, will prevent damage to street infrastructure and adjacent houses.

- The first phase of upgrading the stormwater system will commence in ward 8, Bonnievale from January until July 2015 and thereafter roll over to the 2015/16 financial year. New stormwater lines and structures, to the value of R2 million, will be installed or constructed in accordance with the Bonnievale Stormwater Master Plan.

Water

The following amounts have been allocated towards the upgrading and replacement of water treatment networks within the Langeberg area:

- R400 000 has been allocated in the budget for the installation (and/or replacement) of additional bulk water meters in the Langeberg area. The Langeberg Municipality will implement this project in accordance with The Water Conservation/Water Demand Management Study for Monitoring of Non-Revenue Water.

- At Uitsig, Bonnievale a new, upgraded water network will be installed to the value of R1 million. The upgrading of these existing services will commence and continue during the period July to December 2014.

- To protect water and sewer installations, a new fencing project, to the value of R1,2 million, will commence during the period July to December 2014, which will prevent theft and vandalism of tele-metry systems in all areas within the Langeberg Municipality.



- Construction of a new 3,5 megalitre reservoir and associated water infrastructure in Bonnievale, will allow for additional storage capacity as per the Water Master Plan. The project, valued at R14 170 700, will commence in July and continue until June 2015.

- R2 067 430 has been budgeted for the rehabilitation of the water networks benefiting all areas in the Langeberg. This project comprises the replacement of old water lines as per the Pipe Replacement Prioritisation Programme.

Cleansing

The Cleansing Department of the Langeberg Municipality will be spending the following amounts on development:

- A new loader to the value of R730 000 will be purchased to replace an old loader used for the cleaning of all areas and illegal dumping.

- Purchasing of a double axle high lift compactor, valued at R 2 300 000, to

- replace the existing vehicle used for refuse collection.

- R350 000 has been allocated towards the purchasing of additional wheelie bins, as an ongoing project to replace black refuse bags within the Langeberg area.

- As a legal requirement fencing, to the value of R60 000, will be erected at the McGregor transfer station by August 2014.

Electrical engineering

Substantial amounts will be spent over the next year on the upgrading of electrical services throughout the 12 wards. Several big projects include:

- The installation of electrical services, valued at R614 040, for 130 low cost housing units at Muiskraalkop - Erf 2, Nkqubela, by November 2014.

- The installation of an 11 kV cable feeder, switchgear and metering unit (phase 1) at the Robertson industrial area, to provide electrical supply by June 2015.

- The installation of new house connections, budgeted at R65 000, as per demand in the Langeberg area.

- Upgrading of the existing 11 kV overhead line in Ashton, valued at R400 000, to ensure that the 11 kV line has additional capacity and complies with safety legislation.

- Upgrading of the existing 11 kV overhead line at McGregor-Boesmansrivier, valued at R400 000, to ensure that the 11 kV line has additional capacity and complies with safety legislation.

- Maintenance and or repairs of existing networks, budgeted at R1 300 000, as per demand within the Langeberg area.

- The installation of an 11 kV primary feeder and substation at Robertson North and Extension 9. The project, valued at R4500000, comprises

installing a switchgear and cable between Robertson Main and Goedehoop Avenue substations, to ensure provision of additional supply for Robertson North and new development by March 2015.

- Replacement of the existing 66 kV switchgear at Goudmyn-Le Chasseur substations, to ensure and improve the safety of personnel and the environment. The project, valued at R620 000, is aimed for completion in March 2015.

- Upgrading of the 11 kV overhead line at Eilandia by June 2015. This project, valued at R365 000, will ensure that the existing 11 kV line has additional capacity and complies with safety legislation.

- Upgrading of the existing Klaasvoogds 11 kV overhead line, valued at R250 000, to ensure additional capacity and compliance with safety legislation.

- Replacement of the cherry picker that services all areas in the Langeberg, at a cost of R850 000. The new truck, with aerial platform, will be replaced by February 2015, for the purpose of ensuring the safety of personnel.

- R160 000 has been budgeted for the replacement and repairing of existing street lights in the Langeberg area, as per demand.

- The upgrading of the existing 11 kV supply lines from the Eskom substation to Montagu, in order to ensure additional supply capacity for Montagu. This project is valued at R689 000.

Housing

- The installation or upgrading of bulk services for housing projects in McGregor is valued at R2 900 000. The construction of bulk connector services and upgrading of existing bulk services will accommodate the housing project.

- The project of installing basic services for the development of TRA at Nkqubela, Robertson, is valued at R1 500 000. To provide basic services to residents, it also includes the relocation of informal settlements at Nkanini and Cogmanskloof.

Libraries

The installation of book detectors at Ward 3, Robertson and Ward 9, Ashton. This project, valued at R300 000, will be funded from ad hoc funds from the Provincial Grant.

Residents can also look forward to the next financial year, because the building of the Ashbury Library, to the value of R2 million, has been scheduled in the 2015/2016 budget.

Parks and Recreation

- National funding, to the total amount of R8 000 000 over the next three years, has been awarded to Langeberg Municipality towards the upgrading of parks in previously disadvantaged areas and the upgrading of open spaces within the Langeberg municipal area.

- The upgrading of nature reserves and cemeteries will also be funded from the R8 000 000 budget over the next three years.

- The provincial grant from the Department of Cultural Affairs and Sport allows for a R500 000 upgrade to the McGregor sport field.

- R250 000 has been budgeted for greening projects as part of the Arbor City winning prize.

Waste removal on wheels

About 4 662 residents of Zolani, Robertson, Môreson (Extension 1-4), Burnholm, Sonskyn, Droeheuwel, Dorpsig, Panorama (Extension 15), Happy Valley and Bonnievale, received the new municipal wheelie bins, which will, in time, completely replace the refuse bag system currently being used in Langeberg.

A total of 690 wheelie bins are budgeted for Extension 14 and part of the central town of Robertson, which is next in line to receive bins early in 2015. This is a multi-year capital project and will be rolled out over the course of the next five years to the entire Langeberg municipal area.

The standardisation of the municipal waste collection system will help to ensure an efficient and effective refuse removal service, reduce our carbon footprint in waste removal by doing away with the black bags, improve public awareness of waste management, secure the health and safety of refuse removal teams, and most importantly reduce illegal dumping.

The wheelie bins that are being distributed are clearly marked with LM (Langeberg Municipality) and the name of the town. On the side will be the erf number for each house to assist with identification. The bin will be issued free of charge. However, should your bin be damaged or stolen, it can be replaced at a cost of R450 per bin.

Bins are provided to the property address and should remain there for the next occupant if you leave or sell your property. Should you find a bin that is not yours, please contact us so that we may collect it and return it to the correct address.

This type of program is in line with the municipality's objective of working towards an environmentally friendly and effective waste management system and has proven to increase recycling and decrease waste. This is very beneficial to the future of Langeberg as it not only helps the environment, but also increases the life expectancy of our landfills and reduces operational costs.

The wheelie bins hold nearly three times as much refuse as the black bags: wheelie bins can take up to 240 litres, compared to black bags, which can only hold 85 litres.

Currently the Langeberg Municipality is using the black bag refuse collection system, which requires that each household place their full bags at the kerbside for collection. The wheelie bin system will work on the exact same concept but replaces the black bag. The clear bag that is distributed for recyclable products can be placed on top of the wheelie bin for collection.

How to use your bin

- Do not put concrete, bricks, large stones or large pieces of metal in the bin.

- Do not put hot ashes or corrosive materials in the bin.

- Please try to recycle all recyclable waste by separating and placing recyclables in the clear bag provided by the municipality. Do not place the clear bag in the wheelie bin, but leave it on top of the bin.

- Bins should be clear of overhead obstructions, such as wires and trees, to assist with collection.

- Please don't overfill your bins. Bin lids should be down flat. If not, there may be spillage of waste during emptying of the bins.

Malunga nama-4 662 abahlali baseZolani, eRobertson, eMoreson (e-Extention 1-4), eBurnholm, eSonskyn, eDroëhewel, eDorpsig, ePanorama (e-Extention 15) naseBonnievale, eHappy Valley bafumene imiqomo emitsha enamavili kamasipala, ntoleye, eyakuthi ekuhambeni kwexesha, iguqule kuhphule ngenkubo yokusetyenziswa kwengxowa zenkunkuma nezisetyenziswayo kungoku nje eLangeberg.

Imalunga nama-690 imiqomo enamavili ezaku-thengelwa u-Extention 14 kudibana nengxene ephakathi edolophini yaseRobertson kuba ngabo abalindeleke bafumane imiqomo enamavili ekuqa-leni kuka2015. Le yiprojekti yokuthengwa kwezinto ezihlala ixesha elide yonyaka nganyaka nethi iqhu-tye iminyaka emihlanu, ukuze kuge nokugutun-gelwa ingingqi iphela kamasipala waseLangeberg.

Ukulanganiswa kwenkubo yakamasipala yokuthutha inkunkuma yonceda ukuqinisekisa ukuba in-konzo yokuthuthwa kwenkunkuma yenzeka ngo-kungenazindleko nangempumelelo, kuncitishis-ungcoliseko lwendalo ngokuthuthwa kwenkunkuma ngokuthi kuyekisa ukusetyenziswa kwengxowa ze-plastiki ezimnyama, kuhpuculwe nolwazi loluntu ngokulawula kwenkunkuma, kuqinisekiswe impilo nokuseleko lwamaqela athutha inkunkuma, ngaphetu kwako konke kuncitishiswe ukulahlwa kwen-kunkuma ngokungekho semthethweni.

Le miqomo enamivili ekunikezelwa ngayo ipha-wulwe ngokucacileyo ngombhalo othi LM(Langeberg Municipality) kune negama ledolophu. Ecaleni kubhalwe inombolo yesiza sendlu nganye ukuze kubelula ukuwubona.

Le miqomo izakunikezelwa ngaphandle kwen-lawulo. Sekunjalo, ukuba owakho umgqomo won-akele okanye ubiwe, ungakwazi ukuzifumanelo om-nye kwakhona ngentlawulo engange-R450 ngomqomo. Imiqomo ikuhutshwa ngokwedilisi yendlu nganye kungoko ke kufuneka nawe uwushiy-ile kulo ndlu mhla ufuduka okanye uthengisa indlu ulungiselele omnye umntu ozakuhlala aphi. Ukuba ufumene umgqomo ongengowakho, nceda usitsalele khona ukuze sizokuwuphuthume siwubuyisele kwidilesi efanelekleyleo.

Le nkubo iyahambisana nenjongo kamasipala yokuqhubevisa phambili kwenkubo yokulawula kwenkunkuma enobudlelwano kwindalo nesebenza ngokuyimpumelelo kwaye sele iziphawule ngoku-

nyusa ukuhlaziya ngokutsha kwenkunkuma kunye nokuncitishiswa kwayo.

Le nto inegalelo elincumisayo kwikamva las-eLangeberg nanjengokuba ingancedansi nendalo-nje yodwa, kodwa ithi inyuse ukuvuleleka kweenda-wo zokulahla inkunkuma kananjalo ithobe nexabiso lokunakekelwa kwazo. Le miqomo inamavili yona ithwala umthamo wenkunkuma osondele ngoku-phindweni kathathu kunezongxowa zimnyama ze-plastiki: yona lemiqomo enamavili ingathwala ma-lunga neelitha ezingama-240 xa uthelkisa nengxo-wa ezinyama zeplastiki ezithwala malunga neelitha ezingama-85.

Kungoku nje uMasipala waseLangeberg use-benzisa ingxowa yeplastiki emnyama ukuthutha in-kunkuma, ntoleye ethetha ukuba umzi ngamnye ku-funeka ayikhuphe le ngxowa izeleyo yinkunkuma ayibeki ecaleni kwendlela ukuze ibenokuthuthwa.

Le nkubo yale miqomo inamavili, nayo izaku-sebenza kanye ngolohlobo kodwa yona izakuthatha indawo yengxowa zeplastiki ezimnyama. Yona ing-xowa engenambala nesetyenziselwa ukufaka izinto ezizakuhlaziya ngokutsha kufuneka ibekwe phezu komgqomo ukwenzela nayo ithuthwe.

Uwusebenzisa kanjani umgqomo wakho

- Musa ukufaka ikonkrithi, amatye, izitena ezik-hulu okanye iziqwenga ezinkulu zentsimbi emngqo-men.

- Nceda uzame ukuhlaziya ngokutsha yonke inkunkuma onokwazi ukuyihlaziya ngokutsha ngo-kuthi uyahlule uyifake yona kwingxowa engenambala noyinikwe ngumasipala. Ungayifaki ngaphakathi emgqomeni lo ngxowa kodwa uyibeke ngaphezu kwawo.

- Imiqomo akufuneki isithakale phantsi kwe-zinto ezizizithintelo, ezifana namagcingo kune ne-mithi ukuncedisana nokuthuthwa kwenkunkuma.

- Nceda ungawugcwalsi uphuphumale umgqomo wakho. Isiciko somgqomo kufuneka sibenakho ukuvaleka. Ukuba asenzanga njalo, kungahle ichit-hakale inkunkuma ngexa kuqonqothwa imiqomo.

Ngenkcaciso ephangaleyo malunga nokuthuthwa kwenkunkuma nangosuku efika ngayo eyakho inkonzo yokuthuthwa kwenkunkuma, nceda utsalele iSebe leeNkozo yezeNdalo kwa-023 615 8000.

Vullisverwydering op wieletjies

Sowat 4 662 inwoners van Zolani, Robertson, Môreson (uitbreiding 1-4), Burnholm, Sonskyn, Droeheuwel, Dorpsig, Panorama (uitbreiding 15) en Happy Valley, Bonnievale, het nuwe swart wieletjiesdromme (wheelie bins) ontvang wat met verloop van tyd die vuilgoedsaksstelsel, wat tans in die Langeberg gebruik word, sal vervang.

Daar is begroot vir altesaam 690 dromme vir uitbreiding 14 en 'n gedeelte van Robertson se middedorp wat volgende inlyn is om dromme vroeg in 2015 te ontvang. Hierdie is 'n veeljarige projek wat oor die volgende vyf jaar oor die hele Langeberg-area uitgerol sal word.

Die standaardisering van die munisipale vullis-versamelingstelsel sal help om 'n doeltreffende vullisverwyderingstelsel te verseker, die koolstofvoetspoor te verminder deur weg te doen met swartsakke, die gesondheid en veiligheid van vullisverwyderingspanne te verseker en, die belangrikste, onwettige storting te verminder.

Die dromme wat versprei word is duidelik gemerk met LM (Langeberg-munisipaliteit) en die naam van die dorp. Die erfnommer van elke huis is op die kant van die drom om identifisering te vergemaklik. Die dromme word gratis verskaf. Sou dit egter beskadig of gesteel word, kan dit vervang word teen R450 per drom.

Dromme word aan 'n spesifieke adres toegeken en moet derhalwe daar bly vir die volgende intrekker indien die eiendom verlaat of verkoop word. Sou jy 'n drom vind wat nie aan jou behoort nie, word jy versoek om die munisipaliteit te kontak sodat die drom aan die korrekte adres terugbesorg kan word.

Hierdie program is inlyn met die munisipaliteit se doelwit om na 'n omgewingsvriendelike en effektiewe vullisverwyderingstelsel te

beweeg en is bewys om 'n toename in herwinning en daling in vermorsing tot gevolg te hê. Dit is tot voordeel van die toekoms van die Langeberg aangesien dit nie net die omgewing help nie, maar ook die lewensduur van stortingsterreine verleng en operasionele kostes verlaag.

Die dromme hou bykans drie keer meer vullis as swart sakke. Die dromme kan soveel as 240 liter hou in vergelyking met die 85 liter wat 'n swart-sak kan hou.

Die Langeberg-munisipaliteit maak tans van die swartsak-stelsel gebruik waar inwoners hul vol sakke op die sypaadjie plaas vir afhaling. Die dromstelsel sal op dieselfde beginsel werk, maar vervang die swartsakke. Die deursigtige sakke wat verskaf word vir herwinbare materiale kan bo-op die drom geplaas word vir afhaling.

Hoe om jou drom te gebruik

- Moenie beton, bakstene, groot klippe of enige groot stukke metaal in die drom sit nie.

- Moenie warm as of enige bytende voorwerpe in die drom sit nie.

- Probeer om alle herwinbare materiale te herwin deur dit van ander afval te skei en plaas dit in die deursigtige sak wat deur die munisipaliteit verskaf word. Moenie dié sak binne-in die drom sit nie, maar laat dit bo-op die drom.

- Dromme moet vry wees van enige oorhoofse obstruksie soos drade of takke om afhaling te vergemaklik.

- Moenie dromme oorvol maak nie. Die deksel moet plat wees, andersins bestaan die risiko van storting wanneer die dromme leeggemaak word.
