Langeberg youth benefit from EPWP

"It is all about skilling the unemployed youth, providing temporary relief from poverty and creating a space to gain valuable work experience."

These are the words of Peter Salman, Manager for Local Economic Development (LED) at the Langeberg Municipality, who recently highlighted the success rate of the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) within the Langeberg region.

The EPWP is a national government plan to alleviate poverty by recruiting unemployed South Africans into productive work. The programme is specifically targeted at the unskilled and semi-skilled youth, women and people with disabilities.

A recent meeting was held between Langeberg municipal officials and representatives from both the provincial and national EPWP headquarters at the Council Chambers in Robertson. The aim of the meeting was to touch base, discuss new trends, conduct site visits and plan the way forward for this financial year.

A total of 196 local people are currently participating in this year's programme, which will greatly assist them in acquiring valuable skills and gain much needed

municipalities in the Western Cape that qualified for an increase in the annual allocation due to its success of the implementation of the programme. This is a big step for the unemployed and the youth as the success of the programme means more persons will be recruited to benefit from the EPWP," said Salman.

He added that the number of participants grow each year as more departments participate in the programme by seeking labour intensive methods to carry out their various projects.

The sectors in which EPWP beneficiaries are working include the infrastructure, environmental and social sectors.

For the new financial year, beneficiaries will be involved in the following projects: maintenance of general electrical equipment, credit control, data capturers (Finance department), assistance in IT department, law enforcement project, maintenance of municipal fleet (mechanical workshop), EPWP/LED admin assistant, development of township art routes and township development programme for Nkqubela and Happy Valley.

Nonzaliseko Cekiso, Assistant Director: EPWP, responsible for the coordination of the EPWP environment and culture sector and Cape Winelands District Municipality (CWDM), said this programme directly affects and benefits the communities because it is an opportunity for the unemployed to earn a stipend and gain work experience.

Her plan is to assist the municipality in offering decent work opportunities to the unemployed and disabled, giving people a chance to support their families financially and restore their dignity.



"People need to register themselves on the unemployment database of both the local municipality and the Department of Labour, and should also attend community meetings that serve as a consultation process to advocate work opportunities for the upcoming projects," said Cekiso.

When asked whether she would encourage unemployed people and the youth to join she replied by saying, "Yes, I will definitely encourage the unemployed and youth to be part of this programme.

"It is an opportunity to earn money even if you haven't got any skills or if you are semi-skilled. Some type of train-

ing is offered and when you exit the programme, you should be more marketable and employable."

Solly Siwakamisa, who was the regional EPWP coordinator (CWDM) since 2009, has recently stepped down.

Siwakamisa played a fundamental role in assisting the Langeberg Municipality with laying the foundation of the EPWP at a local level – from design all the way to effectively implementing several projects.

"He has worked tirelessly with us as well as other municipalities in the Cape Winelands region to establish EPWP as a real game-changer. We wish him well in his retirement," said Salman.

Langeberg-jeug trek voordeel uit EPWP

"Die gaan alles oor vaardighede leer vir die werklose jeug, om tydelike verligting van armoede te versaf en om ruimte te skep om waardevolle werksondervinding op te doen."

Dit is die woorde van Peter Salman, bestuurder vir plaaslike ekonomiese ontwikkeling by die Langeberg Munisipaliteit, wat onlangs die sukseskoers van die Uitgebreide Openbare Werke-Program (EPWP) in die Langeberg-streek uitgelig het.

EPWP is 'n nasionale regeringsplan om armoede te verlig deur werklose Suid-Afrikaners te werf vir produktiewe werk. Die program is spesifiek gemik op ongeskoole en halfgeskoole jongmense, vroue en mense met gestremdhede.

'n Onlangse vergadering is by die raadsaal in Robertson gehou tussen Langeberg munisipale amptenare en verteenwoordigers van beide die provinsiale en nasionale EPWP-hoofkantore. Die doel van die vergadering was om wedersydse terugvoer te gee, nuwe tendense te bespreek, besoeke op werkpersele te bring en die pad vorentoe te beplan vir hierdie finansiële jaar.

Altesaam 196 mense neem tans aan hierdie jaar se program deel, wat hulle geweldig sal bystaan om waardevolle vaardighede en broodnodige werksondervinding op te doen.

Vir baie begunstigdes dien hierdie program as 'n stap na toekomstige (voltydse) indiensneming.

werk te hê. Ek weet dit is nie permanent nie, maar met harde werk en toewyding, kan ek aansoek doen vir 'n permanente posisie hier en met die ervaring wat ek opgedoen het weet mens nooit. Dit is waarek ek myself van die res moet onderskei en my waarde moet bewys. Dit is baie moeilik om deesdae werk te kry. Ek is dankbaar dat ek vir my familie kan sorg met die toelae wat ek ontvang. Ek wil vir die werkloses vertel 'begin laag en werk jou pad op; dit is hoe jy dinge bereik,' het Adonis gesê.

'n Bedrag van R1 494 miljoen is in die nuwe finansiële jaar deur die munisipaliteit toegeken, spesifiek vir EPWP-projecte. Dit is 'n verhoging van R64 000 teenoor die vorige finansiële jaar, 'n beloning vir die munisipaliteit se vorige suksesse.

"Ons munisipaliteit is een van slegs ses munisipaliteite in die Wes-Kaap wat gekwalificeer het vir 'n verhoging in die jaarlikse toekenning danksy ons sukses met die implementering van die program. Dit is 'n groot stap vir die werkloses en die ejeug aangesien die sukses van die program beteken meer mense sal gewerf word om by die EPWP te baat," het Salman gesê.

Hy het bygevoeg dat die aantal deelnemers elke jaar toeneem en dat meer departemente elke jaar aan die program deelneem deurdat hulle arbeidsintensieve metodes soek om hul verskeie projekte uit te voer. Die sektore waarin EPWP-begunstigdes werk, sluit in die infrastruktuur-, omgewings- en maatskaplike sektore.

Vir die nuwe finansiële jaar sal begunstigdes in die volgende projekte betrokke wees: onderhoud van algemene elektriese toerusting; kredietbeheer; datavasleggers (finansiële departement); ondersteuning in die IT-departement; wetstoepassingsprojek; onderhoud van munisipale vloot (meganiese werkswinkel); EPWP/LED-administrasie-assistent; ontwikkeling van township-kunsroetes; en township-ontwikkelingsprogramme vir Nkqubela en Happy Valley.

Nonzaliseko Cekiso, assistentdirekteur van EPWP, verantwoordelik vir die koördinering van die EPWP omgewings- en kultuursektor en die Kaapse Wynland Distriksmunisipaliteit (KWDM), het gesê hierdie pro-

gram affekteer en bevoordeel gemeenskappe direk want dit is 'n geleentheid vir die werkloses om 'n toelae te verdien en werksondervinding op te doen.

Haar plan is om die munisipaliteit by te staan om ordentlike werkgeleenthede aan die werkloses en gestremdes te bied, en hulle 'n kans te gee om hul families finansieel te ondersteun en hul waardigheid te herwin. "Mense moet hulself op die werkloosheid-databasis van beide die plaaslike munisipaliteit en die departement van arbeid regstreer, en moet ook gemeenskapsvergaderings bywoon wat as konsultasieproses dien om werkgeleenthede vir toekomstige projekte aan te kondig."

Gevra of sy mense sou aanmoedig om aan te sluit, het sy gesê: "Ja, ek sal definitief die werkloses en jeug aanmoedig om deel van hierdie program te wees. Dit is 'n geleentheid om geld te verdien selfs al het jy nie enige vaardighede nie of al is jy net halfgeskool. 'n Vorm van opleiding word aangebied en wanneer jy die program verlaat, behoort jy meer bemarkbaar en aanstelbaar te wees."

Solly Siwakamisa, wat die streeks-EPWP-koördineerde (KWDM) was sedert 2009, het onlangs die tuig neergelê. Siwakamisa het 'n fundamentele rol gespeel om die Langeberg Munisipaliteit by te staan om die fondament te lê vir die EPWP op 'n plaaslike vlak – van ontwerp regdeur tot die effektiewe implementering van verskeie projekte.

"Hy het onverpoosd saam met ons en ander munisipaliteite in die Kaapse Wynland gewerk om die EPWP as 'n ingrypend veranderende projek te vestig. Ons wens hom voorspoed toe in sy aftrede," het Salman gesê.

I-EPWP sisigcwangciso sikarhulumente kazwelone sokulwana nendlala ngokuthi kuqeshwe abemi boMzantsi Afrika abangasebenziyo kwimisebenzi eneziphumo eziphonakalayo. Le nkubo ijolisse kulutsha olungenasakhono kanye nolo lunezakhono ezingagqibelelango, abasethyini, kanye nabantu abakhubazekileyo.

Mvanje bekunentlanganiso phakathi kwamago-sa kaMasipala waseLangeberg, nabamelie be-EPWP abaphuma koondlunkulu bePhondo noZwel-onke nebibanjelwe kwigumbi lentlanganiso yeB-hunga eRobertson. Iinjongo zale ntlanganiso yakukuzihelanisa, ukuxoxa ngendlela izinto ezi-hambangayo mvanje, ukutyelala kweendawo kanye nokugcwangcisa indlela eyaphambili kulo nyakamali.

Bangama-196 abantu basekuhlaleni abathatha inxaxheba kwinkqubo yalonyaka, ntolayo ezakubanceda kakhulu ekufumaneni izakhono zexabiso kananjalo befumane amava omsebenzini nabawdinga kakhulu.

Uninzi lwabo baxhamlayo, lenkubo ilinyathelo lokuncedansa nabo ukuze bafumane umsebenzi (osisigxina).

U-John Adonis, nothe waxhamla nge-EPWP, no-sele esebeza malunga nesithuba sonyaka kwi-Mechanical Workshop kuMasipala waseLangeberg eRobertson, uthe akawazi ukungalivuyeli elithuba anikwe lona.

"Ndibilela kakhulu ngokufumana lomsebenzi. Ndiyazi ukuba asinguwo owesigxina kodwa ngokusebenza nzima nokuzinikezela, ndingakwazi ukufaka isicelo somsebenzi osisigxina kwalapha kwaye ngamava selendiwafumene, angekhe wazi. Yiyo lonto kufuneka ndizikhwebule kwabanye ukuze ndizibonakalise ukuba ndilulutho.

"Kunzima ukufumana umsebenzi kule mihla. Ndibabulela kuba nje ndikwazi ukondla usapho Iwam ngalemali ndiyifumanayo. Ndifuna ukubaxeleta abo bangasebenziyo ukuthi 'uqala ezantsi usebenzele ukuya phezulu, kwenziwa njalo xa ufunu ukuzuza izinto," utshilo u-Adonis.

Isixa semali esingange-R1 494 000 yezigidi ya-belwe uMasipala waseLangeberg kulonyaka-mali kwaye ijolise kwezoprojeki ze-EPWP. Lo nguchatha wama-R64 000 xana uthelkisa naleyo yony-



aka-mali udlulileyo, oku kuwongwa kukamasipala ngempumelelo ayenza kwixesha elidlulileyo.

"Umasipala wethu nguwo kuphela koomasipala abathandathu kwiNtshona Koloni othe wanelungelo lokufumana lochatha-mali ophuma kwisabelo sonyaka ngenxa yokuba ezenze ngempumelelo ezinkqubo. Eli linyathelo elikhulu kwabo bangasebenziyo kanye nakulutsha njengoko impumelelo yokwenzawa kwezinkqubo ithetha ukuba baza kubabaniniza abantu abaqashwayo nabazakuxhamla ngale-EPWP," utshilo uSalman.

Wongezelele ngelithi inani labo bathatha inxaxheba likhula unyaka nonyaka oko kungexa yokubamaninzi kwamasebe azibandakanya nezinkqubo kuba nawo efuna iindlela zokuqesha kwabantu bokwenza iiprojekti zabo ezaahlukaneyo.

Amacandelo abasebenza kuwo abo baxhamila kwi-EPWP aquka linkonzo Ezingundoqo zikamasi-pala, Ezokusinqongileyo kwakunye namaCandelo ezeNtlalontle.

Isigcwangciso sakhe sesokuba ancedise oom-asipala ngokuthi anikezele ngamathuba emisebenzi aphucukileyo kwabo bangasebenziyo kanye nabo bakhubazekileyo, abantu banikwe ithuba lokuxhasa iintsapho zabo ngokwezimali kube nanjalo ubuyisele isidima sabo.

"Abantu kufuneka babhalise kuluhlu Iwamagama abantu abangasebenziyo kumasipala wendawo yabo kanye nakwiSebe lezeMisebenzi, kwaye bazizi-

mase iintlanganiso ezipathelene neenkubo zokuvavanya uluvo Iwabantu ukuze bakwazi ukukhuthaza amathuba emisebenzi kweziprojekti zikulandela," utshilo uCekiso.

Xa ebebuza ukuba ingaba angabakhuthaza abantu abangasebenziyo kanye nolutsha ukuthi lizibandakanye uphendule ngelithi: "Ewe, ngokuqinisikileyo ndingabakhathaza abantu abangasebenziyo kanye nolutsha ukuba bathathe inxaxheba kwezinkqubo.

Zilithuba lokuzifumanela imali nokuba ngaba awunaso nesinjani isakhono okanye unesakhono esingagqibelelango. Lukhona uqequesho olunikezelawayo futhi xa usele uyishiya le nkqubo, umele ubenamathuba okufumana umsebenzi kwaye ubenakho nokuqashwa."

New financial year, new projects

With the new financial year already under way, the municipality is ready to face new challenges that will cross its path.

"With a combined team effort and a high level of passion, we will address each challenge and continue to promote good governance," says Municipal Manager Soyisile Mokweni.

In terms of the new budget for 2015-'16, it is clear that we always reflect "service delivery" as our main priority.

A total of R13 838 720 has been set aside to erect two new transfer stations, one in Bonnievale and one in Ashton, as part of ensuring excellent cleansing services to our communities.

Various projects concerning the upgrading of community halls in the region will be implemented to the tune of R300 000.

A sum of R5 054 390 has been allocated for the upgrading of electrical infrastructure with the main projects being replacement and repairs of street lights and new connections.

For environmental services, an amount of R850 000 has been allocated for the acquisition of a Ride-on Mower, two 500 l herbicide sprayers and 3 t trucks.

For housing, an amount of R1 500 000 will be pumped into the installation of basic services for



Robertson TRA.

The Langeberg Municipality is aware of technological advances in the IT world and understands

the benefits thereof, thus setting aside R2 024 570 for general Information Communication Technology (ICT) needs and the upgrading of its infrastructure.

"It goes without saying that education is of vital importance not only to the growth within our region but also the wellbeing of our nation."

"Reading plays a massive role in educating oneself," says Mokweni.

We have allocated a total of R2 589 000 for the upgrading of library services and its main project being the building of a new library in Ashbury, Montagu.

As part of the Poverty Alleviation Project, each ward has received R100 000 to implement a project of their choice. Each project should benefit the community.

A sum of R8 969 830 has been set aside for sewerage projects which include: upgrade of Montagu wastewater treatment works; installation of services in Uitsig, two new sewerage tankers.

Just over R5 million has been allocated for the reconstruction of three bridges in the Langeberg region.

An amount of R1 628 780 will be used towards the rehabilitation of municipal roads in Robertson while a further R3 230 000 will go towards the upgrading of storm water system in Bonnievale (Phase 1).

Lastly, a total of R3 528 430 has been allocated for water services.



Nuwe finansiële jaar, nuwe projekte

Met die nuwe finansiële jaar reeds onderweg, is die munisipaliteit slaggereed vir die uitdagings wat oor sy pad sal kom.

"Met 'n gesamentlike spanpoging en hoë vlak van passie, sal ons elke uitdaging aanspreek en voortgaan om goeie regering te bevorder," sê die munisipale bestuurder, Soyisile Mokweni.

In terme van die nuwe begroting vir 2015-'16, is dit duidelik dat ons altyd "dienslewering" as ons grootste prioriteit voorop stel.

Altesaam R13 838 720 is opsy gesit om twee nuwe oorlaastasies op te rig – een in Bonnievale en een in Ashton – as deel van die versekering van uitstekende reinigingsdienste aan ons gemeenskappe.

Verskeie projekte te make met die opgradering van gemeenskapsale in die streek, in die omgewing van R300 000, sal geïmplementeer word.

'n Som van R5 054 390 is toegewys vir die opgradering van elektriese infrastruktuur met die grootste projekte die vervanging en herstel van straatligte en nuwe aansluitings.

Vir omgewingsdienste is 'n bedrag van R850 000 toegewys vir die aankoop van 'n rybare grassnyer, twee onkruid-spuitaens van 500 l elk en 3 t-vragmotors.

Vir behuising sal 'n bedrag van R1 500 000 gebruik word vir die installering van basiese dienste vir Robertson TRA.

Die Langeberg Munisipaliteit is bewus van tegnologiese vooruitgang in die IT-sektor en verstaan die voordele daarvan, dus word R2 024 570 opsy gesit vir algemene behoeftes in Inligtingskommunikasiestegnologie en die opgradering van infrastruktuur.

"Dit is vanselfsprekend dat opvoeding van kardinale belang is, nie net vir groei in ons streek nie maar ook vir die welstand van ons nasie. Lees speel 'n massiewe rol om 'n mensself te onderrig," sê Mokweni. Ons het altesaam R2 589 000 vir die opgradering van biblioteekdienste opsy gesit en, die grootste projek, die bou van 'n nuwe biblioteek in Ashbury, Montagu.

As deel van die Armoedevertligingsprojek het elke wyk R100 000 ontvang om 'n projek van hul keuse te implementeer. Elke projek

moet die gemeenskap bevoordeel.

'n Bedrag van R8 969 830 is opsy gesit vir rielingsprojekte wat insluit: die opgradering van Montagu se riosluwerswerke; die installering van dienste in Uitsig; twee nuwe rioletenkwaens.

Net meer as R5 miljoen is toegewys vir die herboeling van drie brûe in die Langeberg-streek.

'n Bedrag van R1 628 780 sal gaan na die rehabilisasie van munisipale paaie in Robertson en 'n verdere R3 230 000 sal gebruik word vir die upgrading van die stormwaterstelsel in Bonnievale (Fase 1).

Laastens sal altesaam R3 528 430 aangewend word vir waterdienste.

"Oomama bayaxhulumelana ngexesha lokubaliswa kwamabali, abantu abadala nabajongene neenguqu ezinzima ebomini badibana nezihlobo ezitsha, nabasafikisayo nabo bakwadi-bana kwakwelihala-leencwadi," uvalelise njalo.



Langeberg Municipality to erect R4m library in Ashbury

A brand new public library, valued at R4 million, will be built in Ashbury (Montagu) early next year with the aim of bringing fundamental educational services to more than 1 000 learners . . . and several more adults.

According to Daniel Baadjies, Manager for Community Halls and Public Libraries at the Langeberg Municipality, there is an ever-increasing need for public libraries in communities.

The aim is that every person should have access to a public library without the need to make use of public transport.

The municipality will receive an amount of R4 million as a subsidy from the Provincial Library Services to construct the building. The library will be

erected close to the crèche and Ashbury Primary School in Wilger Avenue, and construction will begin in February next year.

"Public libraries sit at the heart of communities. They help create a sense of belonging and respond to the needs of those who use it. There are hundreds of learners attending a school close to where the Ashbury library will be erected, who at the moment have to walk more than 3 km to the nearest library," said Baadjies.

Two new housing schemes have also been developed over the years, which gave rise to an increase in population and contributing to the need for a library. Baadjies mentioned that the concept of public libraries has changed over the past years.

"The core functions of a library these days are not only confined to providing information, promoting literacy and life-long learning, but it is also a place where individuals gather to explore, interact and imagine."

"It is a safe haven for the young to gather and have access to information for school projects, or to read a book, magazine or newspaper. Children sometimes share a small living space with more than one family, and they need the quietness of a library to study for exams. On the other hand, the elderly require a library to sustain their literacy levels and knowledge," said Baadjies.

There are currently 10 libraries (11 when Ashbury library is complete) and 4 mini-libraries in the Lange-

berg region.

When asked whether he has a message to people who don't fancy reading, he responded by saying, "The library will be the social hub of your community. Once you have been there, it will be impossible to stay away. Soon you too will start reading!"

Baadjies concluded that a library also has an important role to play in creating an environment for adult learning in all its forms, both formal and informal.

"In libraries, community-building connections are happening all the time. Moms connect at story-times, elderly people who are often facing difficult life transitions make new friends, and teenagers meet at libraries too," he concluded.

The library will be equipped with:

- Five computers, all with internet access (which can be used free of charge).
- Approximately 14 000 books which include study guides and reference material.
- The staff will be able to choose new books from the provincial library service four times a year.
- A reading room with magazines and newspapers.
- A children's section with children's programs like story-hours.
- An activity hall for library activities.
- Photocopy facilities.
- Computer and printing facilities.



Langeberg Munisipaliteit rig R4m-biblioteek in Ashbury op

'n Splinternuwe openbare biblioteek, ter waarde van R4 miljoen, sal vroeg volgende jaar in Ashbury (Montagu) begin verrys met die doel om fundamentele opvoedkundige dienste te verskaf aan meer as 1 000 leerders . . . en verskeie ander volwassenes.

Volgens Daniel Baadjies, bestuurder vir gemeenskapsale en openbare biblioteke by die Langeberg Munisipaliteit, is daar 'n toenemende behoefte aan openbare biblioteke in gemeenskappe.

Die doel is dat elke persoon toegang tot 'n openbare biblioteek moet hê sonder dat dit nodig is om van openbare vervoer gebruik te maak.

Die munisipaliteit sal 'n bedrag van R4 miljoen ontvang as 'n subsidie van die Proviniale Biblioteekdiens om die gebou op te rig. Die biblioteek sal opgerig word naby aan die crèche en Ashbury Primêre Skool in Wilgerlaan, en konstruksie sal in Februarie volgende jaar begin.

"Openbare biblioteke lê in die hart van gemeenskappe. Hulle help skep 'n gevoel dat mense behoort en reageer op die behoeftes van diegene wat dit gebruik."

"Daar is honderde leerders in die skool waarnaaby die Ashbury-biblioteek opgerig sal word, wat op die oomblik meer as 3 km na die naaste biblioteek moet loop," sê Baadjies.

Twee nuwe behuisingskemas is ook oor die jare ontwikkel, wat aanleiding gee tot 'n toename in die bevolking en bydra tot die behoefte aan 'n biblioteek.

Baadjies noem dat die konsep van openbare biblioteke verander het oor die afgelope jare.

"Die kernfunksies van 'n biblioteek is deesdae nie net beperk tot die verskaffing van inligting, die bevordering van geleterdheid en lewenslange leer nie, maar dit is ook 'n plek waar individue bymekaarkom om te verken, interaksie te hê en te dink."


"Dit is 'n veilige hawe vir die jongmense om te vergader, toegang tot inligting vir skoolprojekte te kry, of om 'n boek, tydskrif of koerant te lees. Kinders deel soms 'n klein leefruimte met meer as een familie, en wat hulle nodig het is die stilte van 'n biblioteek om te studeer vir eksams. Aan die ander kant vereis bejaardes 'n biblioteek om hul geleterdheidsvlakte en kennis te handhaaf," sê Baadjies.

Daar is tans 10 biblioteke (11 as die Ashbury-biblioteek voltooi is) en vier mini-biblioteke in die Langeberg-streek.

Toe hy gevra is of hy 'n boodskap het aan mense wat nie opgewonde is oor lees nie, het hy reageer deur te sê: "Die biblioteek sal die sosiale middelpunt van jou gemeenskap wees. Sodra jy daar was, sal dit onmoontlik wees om weg te bly. Gou sal ook jy begin lees!"

Baadjies het tot die gevolgtrekking gekom dat 'n biblioteek ook 'n belangrike rol het om te speel in die skep van 'n omgewing vir volwasse leer in al sy vorme, beide formeel en informeel.

"In biblioteke gebeur gemeenskapsbou-verbintenisse deurenby. Mammas maak kontak tydens storieë, bejaardes wat dikwels deur moeilike lewensoorgange in die gesig gestaan word maak nuwe vriende, en ook tieners ontmoet by biblioteke," het hy afgesluit.



Die biblioteek sal toegerus wees met:

- Vyf rekenaars met internettoegang (wat gratis gebruik kan word).
- Sowat 14 000 boeke wat studiegidse en naslaanmateriaal insluit.
- Die personeel sal vier keer per jaar nuwe boeke van die provinsiale biblioteek mag kies.
