Bonnievale's 'new' stormwater system nearly complete

"The main purpose of this project is to enhance the capacity of the stormwater system in Bonnievale and sharply reduce the risk of flooding."

So says Neil Albertyn, manager: Project Management, who insists once the upgrades have been completed, it will improve service delivery by ensuring safer roads for motorists and minimising the eventuality of flooding, especially in Main Road.

The total cost of the project will amount to approximately R6,32-million.

Due to regular flooding in Bonnievale's Main Road, a Stormwater Master Plan was compiled during the 2013/14 financial year. This plan indicated several projects that were to be undertaken by the Langeberg Municipality.

During the 2014/15 financial year, the municipality successfully implemented phase one.

"Bonnievale's central business district and its surrounding residential areas had no formalised stormwater system and made use of its irrigation channels to

convey stormwater to the Breede River," said Albertyn.

"During heavy rainfall or stormy weather, the irrigation channels were unable to accommodate the high volumes of water. This is the reason why flooding occurred from time to time in the lower lying areas of Main Road."

He added that this part of Bonnievale never had a dedicated stormwater system.

The construction entails the installation of stormwater pipes varying in size between 375 and 600 mm, manholes and inlet structures. Work is still being done in Main Road between Multisave and the Caltex garage, and in Kerk Street between Main Road and Waterkant Street.

Albertyn mentioned that the upgrades will benefit the entire Bonnievale community due to the fact that all residents living in this area makes use of the central business district, the town's high school and other facilities.

After completion of this project, resi-

dents will notice and experience the effective removal of stormwater. Albertyn mentioned that if these upgrades were not done, possible flooding would occur which would increase the likelihood of damage to property.

He concluded by saying: "The new stormwater system has been effectively designed for a one in 10 year flooding. With this said, the possibility of flooding

has dramatically been reduced in any given year."

The upgrades are nearing completion and it is envisaged that the project will be done early next month (November).



Bonnievale se "nuwe" stormwaterstelsel amper voltooí

"Die hoofdoel van hierdie projek is om die kapasiteit van die stromwaterstelsel in Bonnievale te verhoog en die risiko vir oorstroming drasties te verminder."

So sé Neil Albertyn, bestuurder: projekbestuur, en hy beklemtoon dat die voltooide opgradering dienslewering sal verbeter deur veiliger paaie vir motoriste te verseker en moontlike oorstroming te minimaliseer, veral in die Hoofweg.

Die totale koste van die projek sal ongeveer R6,32 miljoen beloop.

Weens die gerealde oorstroming in Bonnievale se Hoofweg, is 'n stormwa-

termeesterplan gedurende die 2013-2014 finansiële jaar opgetrek. Die plan het verskeie projekte aangedui wat die Langeberg-munisipaliteit moes onderneem. Fase 1 is suksesvol in die 2014-2015 finansiële jaar geïmplementeer.

"Bonnievale se sentrale besigheidsdistrik en die omliggende residensiële gebiede het nie 'n formele stormwaterstelsel gehad nie en het van besproeiingskanale gebruik gemaak om stormwater na die Breërivier te lei.

Gedurende swaar reënval of stormweer was die besproeiingskanale onvol-

doende om die groot volumes water te hanteer. Dit is hoekom oorstromings van tyd tot tyd in die laerliggende dele van die Hoofweg voorgekom het," het Albertyn gesê.

Hy het bygevoeg dat hierdie deel van Bonnievale nog nooit 'n formele stormwaterstelsel gehad het nie.

Die konstruksie behels die installering van stormwaterpype wat in grootte wissel tussen 375 en 600 mm, mangate en inlaatstrukture. Werk word nog in die

Hoofweg en Waterkantstraat. Albertyn het genoem dat die opgraderings die hele Bonnievale-gemeenskap sal bevoordeel weens die feit dat alle inwoners wat in hierdie gebied woon gebruik maak van die sentrale besigheidsdistrik, die dorp se hoëskool en ander geriewe.

Na voltooiing van hierdie projek sal inwoners die doeltreffende verwydering van stormwater op-

merk en ervar. Indien die opgraderings nie gedoen word nie, sal oorstromings waarskynlik voorkom met verhoging van die moontlikheid van skade aan eindom, aldus Albertyn.

Hy het afgesluit met: "Die nuwe stormwaterstelsel is ontwerp vir 'n een uit 10 kans op oorstroming. Die moontlikheid van oorstroming in enige gegewe jaar is dus verlaag."

Die opgradering nader voltooiing en daar word verwag dat die projek vroeg in aanstaande maand (November) voltooi sal wees.

Uthethe wenjenjalo uNeil Albertyn, uMlawuli: Wolawulo IweProjekti, nogxiniise kwelokuba xana luthe lwaggitywa olupuhuliso, luzakuphucula ukunikezelwa lweenkonzo ngokuthi kuqinisekiswe ukuba iindlela zikhuselekile kwabaghubi zimoto kwanjalo kunciphe neziganeko sokukhuliseka, ingakumbi kwindlela enguNkulu.

Isambuku sexabiso yale projeki simlunga ne6.32 yezigidi zeerandi.

Ngexa yezikhukhula ezsoloko zisenzeke kwiNdlela eNkulu yaseBonnevale, Isigcwangciso Esingundoqo Samanzi Emvula saqulunqua kwisithuba sonyaka-mali ka2013-2014. Esi sigcwangciso sasibonisa iiprojeki eziliqela ekwakufanele zisingathwe nguMasipala was-eLangeberg. Kwisithuba sikanyaka-mali ka2014-2015, umasipala usenze ngempumelelo isigaba sokuqala.

"Ngexesha lokuna kweemvula ezinkulu okanye lemo evuthuzayo, lemizila yemibhobho yamanzi okuncencetshela ehamba phantsi komhlaba ibingakwazi ukumelana nalomthamo umkhulu wamanzi. Siso eso isisizathu sokuba kutheni lento kusoloko kusenzeka ukhukhuliseko qho kwindawo ezsemazantsi eNdlela Enkulu," utshilo uAlbertyn.

JetVac machine to boost service delivery

Langeberg Municipality recently acquired a high-tech JetVac machine which is expected to maintain all five of the town's stormwater systems and sewerage networks.

The machine, which costs R3,05 million, is a high pressure jetting and vacuum combination unit to be used to remove sand, stones and other debris from the stormwater and sewer systems.

Maynard Johnson, manager of civil engineering at Langeberg Municipality, explained the machine is not yet in operation. He added the municipality didn't have a machine like this in the past. "This is a

first for us," he said.

"The people who will be managing the machine will have to undergo training before they perform their duties within the various communities. This is an exciting moment for us and we can't wait to get started."

He mentioned after the stormwater systems and sewerage networks have been cleaned, it will function effectively during normal rainfall as the risk of flooding would be minimal.

"If we did not purchase this machine, the risk of flooding would be much higher especially for lower lying areas," Johnson

said, "which could lead to damage of private property. It is for this reason that the machine will play such a crucial role in providing effective and efficient service delivery to the people of Langeberg."

A date for the JetVac machine to make its debut in the community is still to be determined.

The new pre-paid electricity system offers the option to purchase prepaid electricity via the internet. Access to computers, cellphones and tablets with Internet is increasing, while our libraries also offer free access to computers and the Internet. Soon there will be no need to walk or drive far distances and stand in queue's to purchase prepaid electricity.

The new system is currently in the rollout phase, where we have unfortunately experienced unforeseen teething problems when we switched over to the new system on Friday 2 October. Some token numbers was not accepted by the electricity meters.

We humbly apologise for the inconvenience caused. As soon as we noted this problem, we decided to switch back to the old system.

We will switch over to the new system again on Sunday 1 November and believe it will be operating to our expectations. We do, however, request residents, if possible, to please purchase electricity a few days before or after 1 November to ensure you have electricity in case any unforeseen problems, that might restrict purchases on the day, occur again.

Ek is baie opgewonde oor die voorafbetaalde elektrisiteitsstelsel wat tans geïmplementeer word in die Langeberg-munisipaliteit. Ons evolueer met tegnologie om op dienslewering te verbeter, aan-

gesien hierdie nuwe stelsel die aankoop van elektrisiteit baie makliker en toegankliker vir inwoners sal maak.

Die nuwe voorafbetaalde elektrisiteitsstelsel bied die opsie om voorafbetaalde elektrisiteit via die Internet te koop. Toegang tot rekenaars, selfone en tablete neem steeds toe, terwyl ons biblioteke ook gratis toegang tot rekenaars en die Internet bied. Ons sal weer op Sondag 1 November na die nuwe stelsel oorskakel en glo dat dit volgens ons verwagtings sal werk. Ons wil inwoners egter vra om, indien moontlik, elektrisiteit 'n paar dae voor of na 1 November te koop om te verseker dat u elektrisiteit het, sou probleme weer opduik en elektrisiteitaankope op dié dag beperk.

UMasipala waseLangeberg usandul' ukufumana umatshini wehigh-tech JetVac, nekulindeleke ulondoze imibhobho yamanzi emvula kwakunye no-thungelwano lwaleyo yogutulo ikwimo elungile kwi-dolophu zontlanu.

Lo matshini, noxabisa i-3.05 yezigidi zeerandi, ngumtshini okwaziyu ukuthyla kananjalo nokufunxa ngelona qondo liphezulu, wona uzakusetyenziselwa ukususa isanti, amatye kune nenkunkuma kwimibhobho yamanzi emvula kwakunye nakuleyo yo-thungelwano lwemijelo yogutulo.

UMaynard Johnson, uMlawuli: weeNkonzo zo-buNjineli Zoluntu kuMasipala waseLangeberg, uca-cise ngelithi lomatshini awukakasetyenziswa ok-wangoku. Waze Wongezelela esithi uMasipala awu-zange ubanawo umtshini onje ngaphambili, "lo ngowokuqala kuthi."

"Ukuba besingakhange siwuthenge lomatshini, ungcipheko lohkukhuliseko beluya kuba lukhulu ingakumbi kwabo bahlala kwindawo ezsiezantsi, ntoloyezakunciphisa ukuhuliseko. Ngenxa yeso sizathu kanye esizakwenza lomakonzo udlale indima ebalulekileyo yokubonelela ngom-sebenzi wokunikezelwa kweenkonzo ngempumelelo nokungenaxabiso likhulu kubantu baseLangeberg," utshilo uJohnson.

JetVac-masjen sal dienslewering verbeter

Langeberg-munisipaliteit het onlangs 'n ho-tegnologie JetVac-masjen bekom wat na verwagting al vyf stormwaterstelsels en ri-oonetwerke sal onderhou.

Die masjen, wat R3,05 miljoen kos, is 'n hoëdruk spuit- en suigkombinasie-eenheid wat gebruik sal word om sand, klippe en ander vullis uit die stormwater- en riol-stelsels te verwyder.

Volgens Maynard Johnson, bestuurder: siviele ingenieurswese by die Langeberg-munisipaliteit, word die masjen tans nog nie gebruik nie. Hy het bygevoeg dat die munisipaliteit nog nooit so'n masjen gehad het nie, "dis 'n eerste vir ons".

"Die mense wat met die masjen sal werk sal eers opleiding moet kry, voor hulle hul pligte in die verskillende gemeenskappe kan uitvoer. Vir ons is dit 'n opwin-

dende oomblik en ons kan nie wag om te begin nie," het Johnson gesê.

Hy het genoem dat die stormwaterstelsels en riolinetwerke, nadat dit skoonmaak is, doeltreffend sal funksioneer gedurende normale reënval, want die risiko vir oorstroming sal minimaal wees.

"Indien ons die masjen nie gekoop het nie, sou die risiko van oorstroming baie hoër gewees het, veral in die laerliggende gebiede, wat tot skade aan privaateindom sou kon lei. Dit is vir hierdie rede dat die masjen so'n belangrike rol sal speel in die voorsiening van doeltreffende dienslewering aan die mense van die Langeberg," het Johnson gesê.

Die datum waarop die JetVac-masjen in diens gestel gaan word moet nog bepaal word.



Groot Stap bevorder 'n gesonde lewe deur oefening

Die Langeberg-munisipaliteit het saam met die Wes-Kaapse departement van kultuursake en sport vroeër vandeesmaand die tweede Groot Stap by die Happy Valley-sportgronde in Bonnievale aangebied.

Water quality/Waterkwaliteit

It is important that treated water complies with the strict South African National Standards (SANS). Analysis reports are done monthly at these purification plants by an external service provider, the SANS accredited A.L. Abbot and Associates. The latest available report, compiled in September, breaks down the five towns' treated water results and shows the water to be safe according to the SANS 241 standards as indicated in this SANS certificate of analysis report.

Centennial commemoration of Montagu's De Waal Bridge

"This is an historic moment for Montagu and its community," said Francois Daniel de Kock, member of Ward 11's Ward Committee, of the De Waal Bridge's centennial commemoration.

De Kock sketched a picture of the rich history of the bridge in Kohler Street at the commemoration ceremony held at the De Waal Bridge on Thursday 15 October.

Alderman Diana Gagiano, executive mayor of Langeberg Municipality, councillors, municipal officials and members of the public

gathered to celebrate this historic piece of infrastructure.

Gagiano cut the white ribbon and unveiled the statue of commemoration as a permanent reminder that this bridge stood the test of time, reaching its 100th annual milestone.

The bridge, the oldest in the area, is now solely used as a foot crossing. Generally, it is used by learners making their way to and from school. Several years ago, the bridge was used as a one-way for motorists.

Initially, there was no connection between the old town and the Montagu South area. The De Waal Bridge was the only connection between these two areas of the town.

The bridge was officially opened in 1915 by Lady de Waal, wife of the first Administrator of the Cape in the new Union of South Africa, Sir Frederick de Waal, after whom it was named.

After the opening of the first hospital in 1922 in Montagu South, this bridge served as the only river crossing.

Aldus Francois Daniel de Kock, lid van Wyk 11 se Wykkomitee, toe hy 'n prentjie geskets het van die ryk geskeidenis van die De Waal-brug (Kohlerstraat) by die honderdjarige herdenking van die brug in Montagu hierdie maand.

Raadsheer Diana Gagiano, uitvoerende burgemeester van Langeberg-munisipaliteit, raadslede, munisipale amptenare en lede van die publiek het Donderdag 15 Oktober by die De Waal-brug byeengekom om hierdie geskied-

kundige stuk infrastruktur te vier.

Gagiano het 'n wit lint geknip en 'n herdenkingsmonument onthul as 'n permanente herinnering dat hierdie brug die toets van die tyd deurstaan het en sy honderdste verjaardag in 2015 bereik het.

Die brug, wat die oudste in die gebied is, word nou slegs as voetgangerbrug gebruik. Oor die algemeen word die brug deur skoolkinders gebruik na en van die skool. Heelwat jare gelede het motoriste dit as 'n eenrigtingpad gebruik.

Aanvanklik was daar geen verbinding tussen die ou dorp en die huidige Montagu-Suid nie. Die De Waal-brug was die enigste verbinding tussen die twee dorpsgebiede. Die brug is in 1915 ampelik deur Lady de Waal geopen. Sy was die vrou van die eerste Administrateur van die Kaap ná Uniewording in 1910, Sir Frederick de Waal. Die brug is gevolegtlik die De Waal-brug genoem. Na die opening van die eerste hospitaal in Montagu-Suid in 1922, het die brug as enigste oorbrugging van die rivier gedien.
