- (b) Check whether the municipality's approved budget is implemented in Accordance with the service delivery and budget implementation plan;
- (c) Consider and, if necessary, make any revisions to the service delivery and budget implementation plan, provided that revisions to the service delivery targets and performance indicators in the plan may only be made with the approval of the council following approval of an adjustments budget;
- (d) Issue any appropriate instructions to the accounting officer to ensure-
  - (i) That the budget is implemented in accordance with the service delivery and budget implementation plan; and
  - (ii) That spending of funds and revenue collection proceed in accordance with the budget;

The 2014/2015 TOP LAYER SDBIP has been approved by the Executive Mayor on 14 June 2014.

There are some changes that need to be done to the Key Performance Indicator (KPI's) and Council's approval is requested to do these changes on the SDBIP for 2014 / 2015.
