CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

BY SUBSISTENCE PRODUCERS / FARMERS FOR SUPPORT FROM THE PRESIDENTIAL EMPLOYMENT STIMULUS INITIATIVE

The Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development invites applications from subsistence producers / farmers to be supported through the Presidential Employment Stimulus Fund. The main objective of this initiative is to support employment of marginalised producers / farmers. The fund will enable subsistence producers / farmers to retain self-employment in the agricultural sector, thereby contributing to food security and economic growth.

1. Application process is free of charge (you do not need data to apply)

- a. All applications will be done electronically using your mobile phone or a phone of a member of your household. The system only allows one application per household.
- b. The process is like loading airtime.
- c. The USSD number will work on all mobile networks (Vodacom, MTN, Telkom or Cell C); You can use any of the 11 official languages.
- d. Dial *134*4536# on your mobile phone and follow the prompts to choose the commodity that you are applying for, complete steps 1 to step 10.
- e. Once you have completed the process you will be issued with a unique reference number. Save this number for future reference.

2. Farming commodities supported through this initiative

The following commodities and maximum production sizes to be supported are listed below:

- Award sizes will range between R1 000 and R9 000 and are dependent on the support applied for and verified production activity.
- The size of the non-financial e-voucher will be determined after physical verification by the Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development.
