Please note, completing an application does not guarantee that your organization will receive a grant.

All applicants to please ensure that they answer all of the questions and provide as many supporting documents as possible as incomplete or insufficient information will preclude you from consideration.

Also to note that whilst there is a total of R75 000 available in each town, your application need not be for the full amount but rather for an amount that would allow you to initiate or complete a project which would bring value to the community.

Successful applicants will be contacted by 18 March and there will be a ceremonial handover at each of the Absa Cape Epic race villages.
