ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORS-SUPERVISOR

Amstilinx (RF) Proprietary Limited invites all qualifying community members to apply for the positions of Environmental Monitors-Supervisor during the construction of the Excelsior Wind Energy Facility (32MW) project which is located between Swellendam and Bredasdorp.

Preference to be given to community members in the closest towns surrounding the project site namely Swellendam, Suurbraak, Buffeljagsriver, Malgas, Bredasdorp, Napier, Klipdale, Riversonderend, McGregor, Bonnievale, Ashton, Zolani, Montagu & Arniston).

Minimum Requirements - Qualification & Experience:

- Matric Certificate (Gr12) and tertiary (post Gr12) qualifications will be an advantage;
- A valid code EB driver's license.
- Computer literate (especially MS Word and Excel), ability to work with electronic data collection protocols and data submission timing requirements;
- Candidates who have previous field experience with birds and/or bats monitoring will be preferred; and
- Excellent communication skills verbal and writing (English, Afrikaans & IsiXhosa).

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Act as a point of contact for monitoring program related inquiries from the field to the site management and the Environmental Control Officer (ECO);
- Conduct bird monitoring;
- Conduct surveys on foot (up to 10 km per day) in potentially adverse weather conditions and enter data;
- Search for dead or injured birds and bats on foot in amongst vegetation;
- Conduct bird observations for extended periods of time to record behavior and flight patterns; and
- Operate a camera and Global Positioning System (GPS) and record details of carcasses found, and observations made.
