### **1. NATIONAL CERTIFICATE: FURNITURE MAKING: WOOD (UPHOLSTERY) LEVEL 2**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: GRADE 10**

**START DATE: 1 APRIL 2020**

**DURATION: 1 YEAR**

**STIPEND: R2000.00 PER MONTH (PAYABLE ON ATTENDANCE)**

#### **PROGRAMME INFORMATION:**

This qualification will allow candidates to achieve recognition as a furniture maker, and lay a foundation for future career advancement across similar trades.

Upon completion the candidate will have an understanding of the furniture industry, and how he/she should operate within the workplace.

Successful candidates will be able to:

- Prepare products for final finishing operations
- Do hand polishing
- Conventional spraying of sealers
- Positioning and attachment of materials for upholstery
- Attach ready prepared upholstery components to prepared furniture

- Gain competence in the specialized sub fields of plant production (i.e vegetables, fruit production, hydroponics)
- Be able to take responsible decisions based on the sound understanding of the basic principles of good agri-business and practice.
- Be enabled to actively participate in the primary agriculture sector through the production of quality agriculture products
- Become economically sustained and active

### **3. SKILLS PROGRAMME: ASSISTANT CHEF**

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Grade 10**

**START DATE: 1 APRIL 2020**

**DURATION: 6 MONTHS**

**STIPEND: R90.00 PER DAY - PAID MONTHLY (PAYABLE ON ATTENDANCE)**

#### **PROGRAMME INFORMATION:**

This qualification brings together the elements of food and drink preparation, as well as supervision.

Upon successful completion, candidates will be able to:

- Maintain a healthy, safe, secure working environment
- Clean and store crockery and cutlery
- Handle and maintain utensils and equipment, including knives
- Prepare and cook basic fish, fruit, vegetable, egg dishes (hot and cold)
- Prepare and cook basic meat, poultry, game, offal dishes, soup and sauces and basic rice dishes
- Prepare and cook basic fruit, pasta dishes and starch
- Prepare and cook basic hot and cold deserts
