- Students accepted at the relevant tertiary institutions
- Preference will be given, but not limited to:
 - Persons with disabilities, the financially disadvantaged, female learners and applicants from rural areas of South Africa

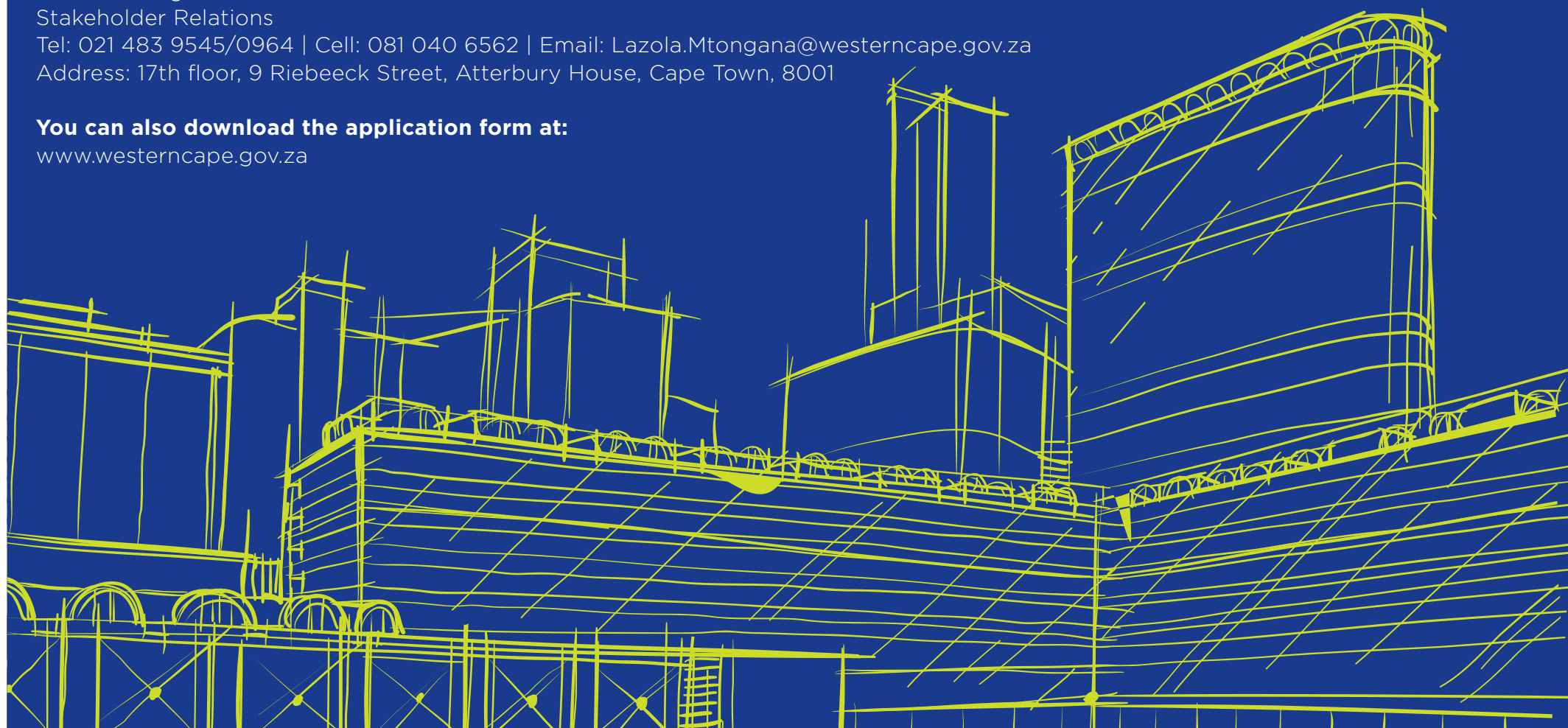
