Munisipaliteit open Nkqubela-biblioteek

'n Langverwagte droom is bewaarheid vir die 6 000 inwoners van Nkqubela in Robertson toe hul eie openbare biblioteek Maandag 25 Oktober sy deure geopen het. Die departement van kultuursake en sport, Langeberg Munisipaliteit en die gemeenskap, het saamgespan om dié biblioteek teen 'n koste van R4,5 miljoen te bou.

Ongeveer 4% van die Robertson-biblioteek se geregistreerde lidmate is van Nkqubela. Voor die bou van die nuwe biblioteek moes inwoners sewe kilometers ver loop na die naaste biblioteek. Tot 75 van die Masakheke Hoërskool se leerders het die Robertson-biblioteek daagliks na skool besoek om te studeer of projekte te voltooi.

Die eerste biblioteekdiens in Nkqubela was uit 'n vraghouer aangebied met leesstof wat deur Bibione geskenk is. Die diens is egter gestaak as gevolg van 'n geldtekort om die personeel te betaal.

Die nuwe biblioteekgebou is in Augustus vanjaar finaal voltooi.

Leerders van die Nkqubela Primêre Skool en die Masakheke Hoërskool gaan grootliks baat by die projek met toegang tot meer as 12 912 boeke ter waarde van R719 000 om die leerders met hul projekte en studies te help. Die biblioteek verskaf ook kopieërdienste, internet-toegang en inligting vir navorsing. Leerders word aangemoedig om van al hierdie dienste gebruik te maak.

Die geriewe in die nuwe biblioteek belooft om nie net leerders nie, maar ook lede van die Langeberg-gemeenskap wat werkloos is, te help. Werkloos sal die dienste kan gebruik om inligting te kry oor tenders en beskikbare werksgeleenthede. Die biblioteek het ekstra vertrekke vir opvoedkundige aktiwiteite en werkswinkels met rekenaar-geriewe vir aanbiedings via televisie en 'n projektor met 'n groot skerm.

Die dagsentrum vir seniors met sy 45 lidmate sal ook by die biblioteek baat



vind. Die gebruik van die biblioteek sal seniors se leesvermoë verbeter en dus ongeletterdheid uitwis.

Twee personeellede gaan die publiek bystaan terwyl 'n tuinier en 'n skoonmaker 'n netjiese omgewing sal skep.

Die minister van kultuursake en sport, dr. Ivan Meyer, het gesê die biblioteek gaan die leertoestande in Nkqubela bevorder en stimulasie en vermaak aan die inwoners verskaf. "Hierdie biblioteek is 'n uitnemende program waardeur mense tot die wêreld verbind kan bly. Dit gaan 'n nuwe wêreld van geleenthede vir die gemeenskap oopmaak," het hy gesê.

Meyer het ook 'n verskeidenheid boeke uit sy eie versameling aan die biblioteek geskenk.

Die uitvoerende burgemeester van die Langeberg Munisipaliteit, raadsheer Daniela Gagliano, het gesê die mense van Nkqubela kan die biblioteek gebruik as 'n poort na inligting en 'n beter toekoms.

Iphupha ebelikade lilindelwe lide lazalisekiswa ku-bahlali abangama-6 000 baseNkqubela eRobertson xa bekuvulwa elabo ithala-leencwadi loluntu ngoMvulo, 25 Novemba 2013. ISebe leMicimbi yeNkcubeko neMidlalo libambisene noMasipala waseLangeberg kunye noluntu ekwakhiweni kwethala-leencwadi elixabisisa izigidi ezingama-4,5 zerandi.

Malunga nesine ekhulwini samalungu abhalise kwithala-leencwadi laseRobertson aphuma eNkqubela. Kude kube kuvulwa eli ziko litsha, amalunga ebhamba umgama ongange-7km ukuya kwithala-leencwadi eliseRobertson, abanye babo behamba ngeenyawo. Malunga nama-75 abafundi baseMasakheke bebesebenzisa ithala-leencwadi laseRobertson mihla le, emva kwisikolo beyokufunda kananjalo nokuyokwenza iiprojekti zesikolo.

Inkonzo yokuqala yethala-leencwadi eNkqubela yayinikezelwa kwisakhiwo samankcenkce esigumbi linye nelalisibonelele sakwaBibliotek, kodwa ukunqongophala kwemali yokuhlulwa kwabasebenzi kwakhokhelela ekuvalweni kwelo ziko ngo2011. Indingeko yethala-leencwadi elifaneleki-leyo laye lathathelwa ingqalelo kwiSigwangciso Sophuhliso Esinxibeleleneyo soMasipala waseLangeberg kananjalo kwaye kwenziwa isicelo senkxaso-mali esinemigathango esafakwa kwiNkqubo yeMathala-eencwadi eyi-DCAS.

Isakhiwo sagqitywa sona ngoJuni 2013. Noxa ukuqunjelwa kakuhle kwawo wonke umsebenzi kwaba ngomhla wesi-7 Agasti 2013, emva kokuba kuqoshelwe zonke izinto bezingagqibelelanga, ukulungiswa kwezo bezingasebenzi kakuhle kunye nezozazinomakalo ungephi.

Abafundi beSikolo saMabanga Aphakathi baseNkqubela kunye nabeSikolo saMabanga Aphakamileyo baseMasakheke kunye nabanye abaninzi kulindeleke bazuze lukhulu. Abafundi ngoku bangazifumanela ulwazi kwiincwadi ezingama-12 912 nezixabiso malunga nama-R 719 000 ukuncedisana nezifundo zabo kwakunye nokuphucula ukubalaselele kwamathuba abo ngokwefundo. Ithala-leencwadi aliyikukhupha iincwadi nezixhobo zokufunda kuphela kodwa lizakubonelela nangomatshini wokukopa, ngeenkono ze-intanethi kunye neenkono ezingeenkcukacha malunga nophendlo. Abafundi bayakhuthaza ukuba bazisebenzise zonke ezin-

konzo ziveleleke kubo.

Izixhobo ezikumathala-eencwadi azenzelwanga ukunceda abafundi kuphela koko namalungu asekuhlaleni awakhangela imisebenzi. Bazakubanakho ukusebenzisa ezi nkono ukuze bazi malunga nezinye-izixhobo ezivelileyo kwakunye nemisebenzi. Ukongezelela, kukwakho negumbi elinokusetyenziselwa imisebenzi yezenfundo okanye iintlanganiso, lona linekhompyutha eqhagamshelwe ikhuphelele iingcebolo kumabonakude nakwi-projektha onokuzisebenzisa xa unentlanganiso.

Kwakhona, indawo ekugcinwa kuyo abantu abadala nenamalungu angama-45 kungokunje, lo malungu asenakho ukusebenzisa eli thala-leencwadi. Ukusetyenziswa kwethala-leencwadi ngabantu abadala kothi kuphucule ukuze bakwazi ukufunda nto leyo eyothi ithomalalise, isuse kananjalo ukungakwazi ukufunda nokubhala.

Ngabasebenzi ababini abazakuncedisela uluntu ngoxa umsebenzi wasegadini kunye nococayo bona bazakuqinisekisa ukubukeka nokucoceka kokusingqongileyo.

UMphathiswa weMicimbi yeNkcubeko neZemidlalo uGqirha Ivan Meyer uthe elithala-leencwadi lizakuphucula iimeko zokufunda zaphala eNkqubela futhi lizise iimvakalelo nokuzonwabisa kubahlali. "Eli thala-leencwadi yinkqubo ebalaseleyo nabano-kuthi ngayo bahlale beqhagamshelane nelizwe. Lizakuvula amathuba amatsha ehlabathi kuluntu." UGqirha Ivan Meyer uze neencwadi ezahlukeneyo ezithatha kuvimba wakhe wenqokelelo, nathe wanikezela ngazo kwelithala-leencwadi.

Buckle up! It takes a second to save a life

On Thursday 21 November Safely Home, together with the Transport and Public Works road safety partners, launched the "It Takes a Second to Save a Life" campaign, targeted at the province's leading class of fatalities, people who die in vehicles (drivers and passengers).

This campaign is aimed at increasing awareness around the urgent need for more seatbelt compliance amongst road users in the Western Cape. During the festive season, the roads are at their busiest and most dangerous. Start your holiday trip by clicking on your safety belt as soon as you get into any vehicle!

Research has shown that increased seatbelt compliance will mean thou-

sands of lives saved which would otherwise have been lost in the horrific crashes that plague our roads. Failure to use a seatbelt is a certain route to death or serious injury during collisions. When a motor vehicle crash occurs, the occupants who are not restrained continue to move forward at the same speed at which the vehicle was travelling before the collision. They are catapulted forward into the structure of the vehicle, into other occupants or hurled from the vehicle to almost certain death. This horror is experienced daily on our roads, and can be avoided by the simple act of BUCKLING UP.

Also harrowing are the findings of a study conducted by the Stellenbosch

University's Emergency Medicine Unit (reported in the *Cape Argus* in August). This study revealed that in Cape Town alone:

■ Only 25% of the city's motorists wore seatbelts (23% male and 29% female);

■ Most severe injuries were sustained by those who were not wearing seatbelts at the time of the collision;

■ Rear passenger seatbelt usage was at an alarming 8.3%.

Statistics reveal that this year alone (from January till September):

■ 920 people have died on our roads;

■ of the total, 183 have been drivers and 237 have been passengers;

■ Therefore, of the total, 420 have been vehicle occupants, accounting for a staggering 46%.

Many of these deaths could certainly have been avoided had occupants of vehicles involved in crashes, been appropriately restrained.

Seatbelts are important personal protection equipment. Like hard hats, safety glasses, and hard toe shoes in the industry, seat belts help to decrease the severity of, or prevent, injuries when crashes occur.

Wearing a seatbelt reduces the risk of fatal injuries by 40-50% for drivers and front seat occupants and by up to 75% for rear seat occupants (WHO, 2013).

Children are the most tragic victims in these senseless deaths. Road fatalities are the greatest single cause of death in children under the age of 12, and most of them were not buckled up. In 2010, it was observed that 92% of back-seat passengers (including children) are not properly restrained.

Buckling up is known to reduce the risk of death in passenger cars by up to 80% (Medical Research Council 2009; National Mortality Information Surveillance System 2008).

We ask you to help us to achieve a sustainable behavioral change and create a culture of "Buckling Up".

Gordel vas! Dit kan lewens red

Gordel vas - dit neem net 'n minuut om 'n lewe te red!

Die "It Takes A Second To Save A Life"-veldtog het Donderdag 20 November afgeskop. Dit is spesifiek gerig op voertuigbestuurders en passasiers, wat beskou word as die groep waaronder die grootste aantal padsterftes voorkom.

Die veldtog word deur Safely Home, in samewerking met die departement vervoer en openbare werke, aangebied.

Die veldtog is daarop gemik om die belangrikheid om vas te gordel aan motoriste in die Wes-Kaap oor te dra.

Die paaie is gedurende die feesseisoen besiger en gevaarliker as ooit. Begin dus jou vakansiereis deur jou veiligheidsgordel vas te maak die oomblik dat jy in jou voertuig klim en nog voor jy wegtrek.

Navorsing toon dat deur vas te gordel, duisende lewens gered word wat andersins in gruonelukke, wat so gereed op ons paaie plaasvind, sou gesterf het.

Om nie vas te gordel nie is 'n seker paadjie na die dood of ernstige beserings gedurende 'n botsing. Wanneer 'n motorbotsing plaasvind, word insittendes wat nie vasgordel is nie, vorentoe geslinger teen dieselfde spoed as waarteen die voertuig vorentoe be-

weeg het voor die botsing. Insittendes word vorentoe, in ander insittendes vas of uit die voertuig geslinger na hul dood.

Hierdie gruwels vind daagliks op ons paaie plaas en kan voorkom word deur eenvoudig net vas te gordel.

Net so grusaam is die bevindinge van 'n studie deur die Universiteit Stellenbosch se Noodmedisyne-eenheid (wat slegs in Kaapstad gedoen is en in die Cape Argus in Augustus verskyn het). Die bevinding was dat:

■ slegs 25% van die stad se inwoners sitplekgordels gedra het (23% mans en 29% vroue);

■ die ernstigste beserings was by motoriste wat nie vasgordel was nie;

■ slegs 8,3% van die insittendes op die agtersitplek het sitplekgordels gedra.

Volgens statistiek vir Januarie tot September vanjaar het:

■ 920 mense op ons paaie gesterf;

■ 183 van hulle was die bestuurders van voertuie en 237 was passasiers;

■ 240 (46%) van dié sterfgevälle was insittendes in voertuie.

Baie van hierdie sterftes kon verhoed gewees

het as die insittendes vasge-

gordel was.

Sitplekgordels is belangrike beskermingstoerusting vir insittendes in voertuie. Soos hardehoede, veiligheidsbrille en hardetoon-skoene wat in die nywerheid vereis word, help sitplekgordels om die graad van beserings in botsings te verminder of te voorkom.

Die dra van 'n sitplekgordel verminder die risiko van noodlottige beserings met 40 tot 50% vir die bestuurders van voertuie en passasiers op die voorste sitplek en tot 75% vir passasiers op die agtersitplek. (WHO, 2013)

Daar is bevind dat deur vas te gordel, die risiko van sterftes in passasiersvoertuie met tot 80% verminder word. (Mediese Navorsingsraad: National Mortality Information Surveillance System 2008).
