The Langeberg Municipality will be spending a total of R101 million in the next financial year, to upgrade and improve infrastructure within the municipal area. The projects, identified in the 2021/22 Budget Plan, starts from July 2021 and marks the start of the Municipality's new financial year.

Load shedding checklist Prepare yourself by doing the following



Keep your **cell phone** fully **charged** **when the power is on.** If your cellphone battery is low, remember that you can use your car charger in your car or power packs.

Invest in a small **LP gas lamp** for good quality lighting over a large area.

Prepare meals beforehand in case of a power outage.



Install **solar powered** security and garden **lights.**





Never leave lit candles unattended and **keep out of reach of children.** Always extinguish candles before going to bed.

Remember to **switch off your oven** if it was on when the power outage started.



Keep boiled water in **thermos flasks** for hot drinks during a power outage.

Invest in a small **LP gas heating ring** for essential cooking and to boil water for hot drinks - make sure you have an extra bottle of gas.

Make use of **surge protection:** Electric surges are one of the biggest causes of damage to equipment during a power outage. **Installing a surge protection device** can help minimise damage.

Keep **frozen bottled water** in your freezer to help **keep food cold** during a power outage.

Keep a battery-powered **torch** or **candles** in a place where it will be easy to find in the dark - make sure you have an extra set of fresh batteries.



Keep a **small torch** on your bedside table at all times - make sure you have an extra set of fresh **batteries.**



Keep **refrigerator and freezer doors closed** at all times - a power outage of four hours should not cause food spoilage and a freezer should keep food frozen and safe for at least a day.

Back up your data: Make it a priority to save your data offsite, in case of a hard drive crash or unforeseen electrical fault. Online "cloud-based" backups are very convenient and are mostly automated, which means that you have one less thing to worry about.



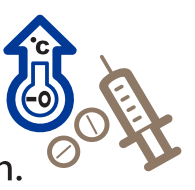
Access, security and safety always remain a top priority - Know where the manual release lever of your electric garage door opener is located and how to operate it.



Also keep a **key to your house** with you if you regularly use the garage as the primary means of entering your home, in case the garage door will not open.



Most **medication** that needs **refrigeration** can be kept in a closed fridge for several hours without spoiling - it is essential that you check with your doctor or pharmacist to be sure about your type of medication.

- 4. Enable quick processing of your request** Ensure that you have the following available:
 - Municipal account number
 - Identity document
 - A valid email address to be linked to your account

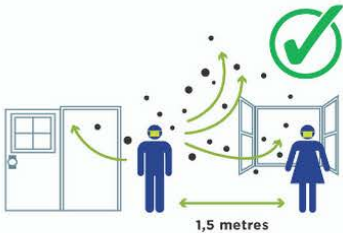

Langeberg Municipality annually showcases performances of the service providers that they co-fund – usually for one night, in one of the community halls within the municipal area.

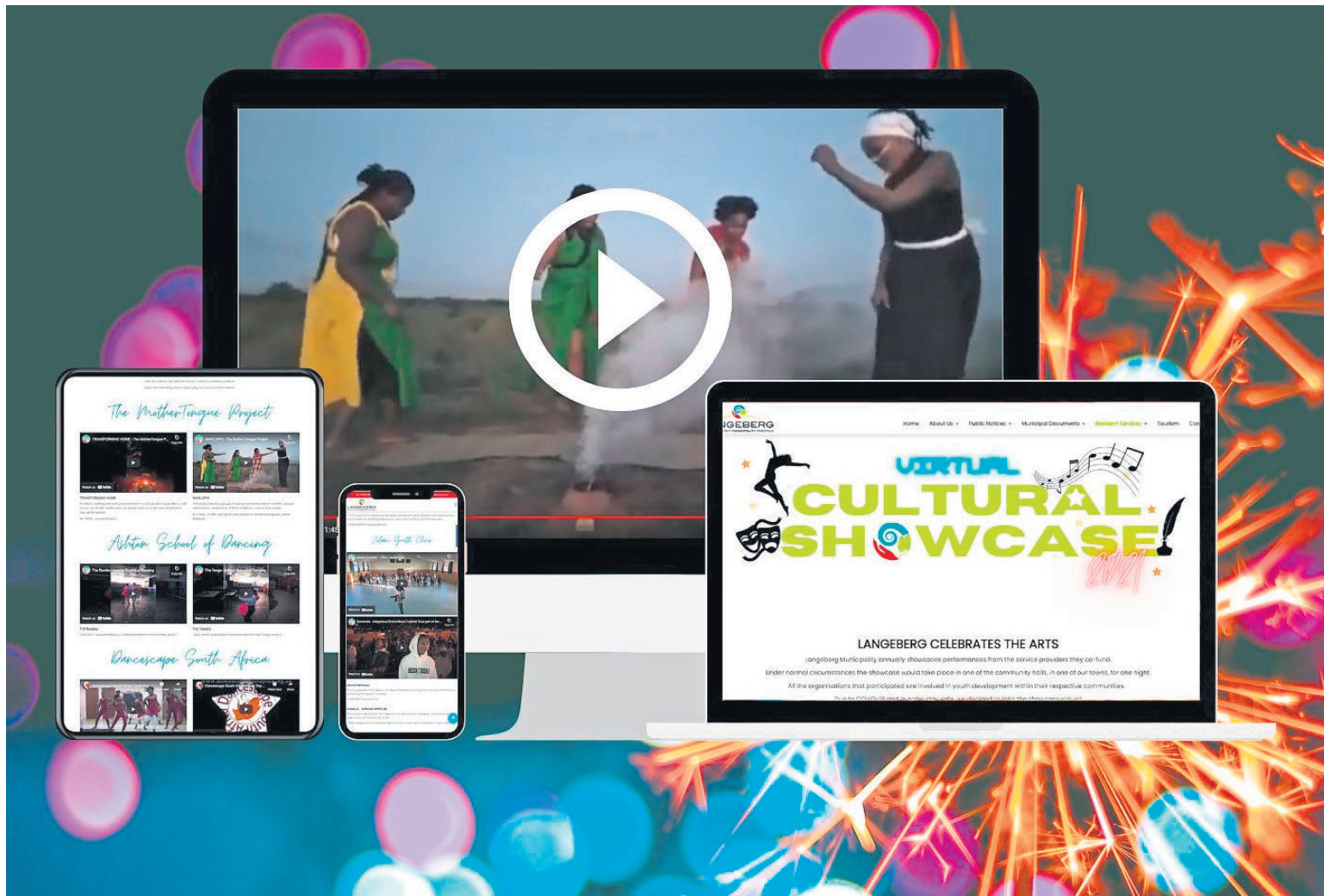
However, because of Covid-19 and the regulations in place presenting a showcase at a community hall would mean that only a few people would be able to attend. To maintain safety and still make the showcase accessible to all the municipality has created a webpage to upload performances of the various service providers onto.

"We are now able to share local talent with anyone who has access to the internet from anywhere in the world," said Octavia Richards-Liemens (Principal Clerk, Local Economic Development). "You can watch the performances in the comfort of your home, or anywhere else you prefer."

The virtual showcase includes performances by Dancescape South Africa, the Zolani Youth Choir, the Mothertongue Project and the Ashton School of Dancing. All the participating organisations are involved in youth development within their respective communities.

Richards-Liemens also emphasised the importance of art among our youth: "Involvement in arts and culture boosts the youth's self-esteem and develops their character. They become more confident, well-mannered, hardworking and goal-driven, especially when they realise what they are doing, could become a career."

Langeberg- kulturele vertoning virtueel aangebied

Die Langeberg-munisipaliteit vertoon elke jaar optredes van die diensverskaffers wat hy help finansier – gewoonlik een aand in een van die gemeenskapsale in die munisipale gebied.

Vanjaar sou dit vanweë Covid-19 en die regulasies wat ingestel is, beteken slegs 'n paar mense sou 'n vertoning in 'n gemeenskapsaal kon bywoon. Om veiligheid te handhaaf en die vertoning

steeds toeganklik vir almal te maak, het die munisipaliteit 'n webblad geskep om die optredes van die verskillende diensverskaffers daarop te laai.

"Ons kan nou plaaslike talent met enigiemand wat toegang tot die internet het – oral in die wêreld – deel. Jy kan die optredes in die gemak van jou huis sien, of op enige ander plek waar jy verkies", het Octavia Richards-Liemens

(hoofklerk, plaaslike ekonomiese ontwikkeling) gesê.

Die virtuele vertoning behels optredes deur Dancescape Suid-Afrika, die Zolani-jeugkoor, die Moedertaalprojek en die Ashton-dansskool. Al die deelnemende organisasies is by jeugontwikkeling in hul onderskeie gemeenskappe betrokke.

Richards-Liemens het ook die belangrikheid van kuns onder die jeug

beklemtoon: "Betrokkenheid in kuns en kultuur verhoog die jeug se selfbeeld en ontwikkel hul karakter. Hulle word meer selfversekerd, goedgemanierd, hardwerkend en doelgerig – veral wanneer hulle besef dit wat hulle doen, kan 'n loopbaan word."

UMasipala waseLangeberg qho ngonyaka ubonisa imibonisa evela kubaboneleli benkonzo nabanegalelo lenkxaso-mali kuwo, evamise ukuba kwelinye lamaholo oluntu, kwenye yeedolophu zethu, kubusuku obunye.

Nangona kunjalo, ngenxa yeCOVID-19 kunye nemigaqo emiselweyo, umboniso okwiholo yoluntu ubuyaku kuthetha ukuba ngabantu abambalwa kuphela abaya kubanakho ukuya. Ukuwenza umboniso ukufikeleleke kananjalo ukhuseleke,

umasipala wenza iwebhusayithi apho bafake khona imiboniso eyahlukeneyo esuka kubaboneleli ngeenkonzo.

"Siyakwazi ukwabelana ngeentente zakule ndawo naye nabani na, naphi na ehlabathini okwaziyo ukufikelela kwi-intanethi. Ungakwazi ukuzibukelela lemiboniso kamnandi usekhaya, okanye naphi na apho uthanda khona", utshilo u-Octavia Richards-Liemens (Igosa EliyiNtloko, loPhuhliso lwezoQoqosho lwaseKhaya).

Imiboniso eyenziwe ngokusetyenziswa kweekhompuyutha iquka iDancescape yaseMzantsi Afrika, Ikwayala yoLutsha yaseZolani, iProjeki yeMothertongue kunye neSikolo soMdaniso saseAshton. Yonke imibutho ibithatha inxaxheba iyabandakanyeka kuphuhliso lolutsha oluhlala kwezondawo bakwahlala kuzo.

URichards-Liemens kwakhona uye wagxininisa ekubalulekeni kweekhompuyutha phakathi kolutsha: "Ukuzibandakanya kubugcisa kunye nenkcubeko kukhuthaza

ukuzithemba kulutsha kwaye bayakheka ngokwezimilo zabo. Baye bazithembe ngakumbi, baziphathe kakuhle, basebenze nzima kwaye babe ngabaqhutywa zinjongo. Ngokukodwa xa besazi okokuba into abayenzayo inokuba likhondo lokuphila".

How to register to vote

To vote in elections in South Africa you need to first register as a voter.

- Who can register as a voter?**
- You must be a South African citizen.
 - You must have a South African green bar-coded identity document (ID), a smart ID card or a temporary ID certificate.
 - You must be 16 years or older (but you will be able to vote only when you are 18 years or older).
 - You have to register in person. Nobody can do it for you.

Once you have registered to vote, you do not need to re-register in future elections unless:

- You have moved house and are living in a different voting district.
- You have been affected by the re-drawing of the voting district and/or ward boundaries

REMEMBER: If you do not have your green barcoded ID book, a smart ID card or temporary ID, you need to apply for one at the Department of Home Affairs.

- Why should you register?**
- You should register to be included on the national common voters' roll.
 - If you don't register, you cannot vote, and if you don't vote, you are giving up a very important way of making your voice heard.
 - It is your right and responsibility to register.

- Where can you register?**
- Register at your local Electoral Commission (IEC) office from Monday to Friday during office hours. Registration is ongoing, so you can register at any time, whether an election is taking place or not.
 - Register to vote in person at a registration station in the voting district in which you live. The IEC opens its registration stations during a registration weekend just before general elections.

- How does registration work?**
- When registering at your registration station or local IEC office (using IEC Voter Management Device-VMD) the bar code of your ID book or smart ID card or temporary ID certificate will be scanned. This receipt will be SMSed or emailed to you, and will show:
- Proof of application
 - Your ID number
 - The voting district number of your voting station
 - Date and time of your application.



REMEMBER: You must provide sufficient details of where you live (a full residential address or a description of where you live) for the IEC to confirm that you are registering in the correct voting district. Proof of address is not needed.

- If you give false address information it is a crime. You could go to jail for up to 10 years.
- Your ID will be checked when you vote to make sure that it is you.

- How to check if you are registered and that your voters' roll address is up to date**
- Registration will take no more than 24 hours to process.
 - Check at your local IEC office from Monday to Friday during office hours. SMS your ID number to 32810 (R1 per SMS).
 - Go to the IEC website www.elections.org.za and follow the link 'Am I registered to vote?'
 - Check the voters' roll at your voting station, where you are registered to vote, during the voter registration weekends.
 - As a registered voter you can visit www.elections.org.za and create a secure profile for yourself, check and update or provide your voters' roll address.
 - You can also help family and friends to check; remember you will need their ID number, full name, address and cellphone number or email address to check and update their voters' roll address.
 - Even if you are registered, remember to check that your voters' roll address is up to date.

Hoe om te registreer om te stem

Inwoners moet eers as kieser registreer om vir 'n verkiesing in Suid-Afrika te kan stem.

Wie kan as kieser registreer?

- Jy moet 'n Suid-Afrikaanse burger wees.
- Jy moet 'n Suid-Afrikaanse groen strepieskode-identiteitsdokument (ID), 'n slim ID-kaart of 'n tydelike ID-sertifikaat hê.
- Jy moet 16 jaar of ouer wees (maar jy mag eers stem as jy 18 jaar of ouer is).
- Jy moet persoonlik registreer. Niemand kan dit vir jou doen nie.

Nadat jy geregistreer het om te stem, hoef jy nie weer vir toekomstige verkiesings te registreer nie, tensy:

- Jy verhuis het en nou in 'n ander stemgebied woon.
- Jy geraak is deur die herontwerp van die stemdistrik en/of wyksgrense.

ONTHOU: As jy nie 'n groen strepieskode-ID, 'n slim ID-kaart of tydelike ID het nie, moet jy by die Departement van Binnelandse Sake daarvoor aansoek doen.

Hoekom moet jy registreer?

- Jy moet registreer om in die nasionale algemene kieserslys opgeneem te word.
- As jy nie registreer nie, kan jy nie stem nie, en as jy nie stem nie, verspil jy 'n baie belangrike kans om jou stem te laat hoor.
- Dit is jou reg en verantwoordelikheid om te registreer.

Waar kan jy registreer?

- Registreer by jou kantoor by jou plaaslike verkiesingskommissie (OVK) van Maandag tot Vrydag gedurende kantoorure. Registrasie is voortdurend, sodat jy te eniger tyd kan registreer, of 'n verkiesing plaasvind of nie.
- Registreer om persoonlik by 'n registrasiestasie in die kiesdistrik waarin jy woon, te stem. Die OVK open sy registrasiestasies tydens 'n registrasie-naweek net voor die algemene verkiesing.

Hoe werk registrasie?

Wanneer jy by jou registrasiestasie of plaaslike OVK-kantoor registreer (deur die IEC Voter Management Device of VMD te gebruik), word die strepieskode van jou ID-boek, slim ID-kaart of tydelike ID-sertifikaat geskandeer. Hierdie kwitansie sal

per SMS of per e-pos aan jou gestuur word en sal die volgende wys:

- Onthou om jou kiesersadres na te gaan en seker te maak dat dit op datum is – selfs as jy geregistreer is.
