

MEET OUR COMMUNITY LIAISON WORKERS

Community Liaison Workers work hand-in-hand with Ward Committees to ensure effective public participation as the link between the community and government.

These 7 CLW's play a key function to

- Provide assistance to ward committees
- Communicate municipal and government projects to communities
- Arrange and communicate Ward Committee activities, community meetings and ward committee elections
- Co-ordinate teams of volunteers for community projects
- Assist communities to submit and develop proposals for inclusion in the IDP and other government plans
- Inform communities of problems with service delivery
- Assist committees with the completion of quotations and tender documents
- Assist the implementation of community projects
- Monitor and report back on community projects

They interact with our local residents keeping them informed and involved in community projects to maintain a good relationship between the community and council.

CLW's together with Ward Committees and Councillors are the 'go-to' person in your block or Ward that can inform you about municipal matters and make you part of the municipal decision-making processes. For example, the Integrated Development Plan (IDP) process, the budget, policies, by-laws, council projects, etc.

They are the eyes and ears on the ground, for the municipality, to help identify and initiate projects that could improve the living conditions in your block and assist with awareness processes and programs.

The Ward Committee has the duty to then monitor the quality of service delivery and the overall performance of the municipality and council.
