- 3. Tour Guide training and Township history data collection through surveys

The Municipality thus invites suitably inclined candidates to submit a short profile of themselves detailing their involvement in the specific genre they wish to apply for.

The artists will be asked to submit pieces of their current as part of the evaluation Evaluation will done by a service provider that has experience each the genres. Interested parties must submit their profiles in the nearest municipal office in a box marked Township arts development programme clearly specifying which of the three components is applied for.
